**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This 16 hour NFA course examines the Safety Officer's role in emergency responses to all-hazards type incidents and will focus on operations within an Incident Command System (ICS).

**Target Audience:** Individuals who currently have Safety Officer responsibilities or are planning to serve as a Safety Officer. Persons attending this course should have knowledge of ICS, building construction principles, hazardous materials management, applicable NFA guidelines and federal regulations.

**STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:**
