COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 2-day NFA course identifies operational activities and safety concerns for structural company officers assigned to a Wildland/Wildland Urban Interface incident. Topics covered include Introduction to Wildland/Wildland Urban Interface firefighting, interface environment, wildland fire behavior, command control issues of wildland/urban interface firefighting, and tactics.

Target Audience: Company officers or chief officers who may be in command of a single resource or Strike Team at the scene of a Wildland/Wildland Urban Interface incident.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:
