AST is pleased that many people had plans in place to not drive impaired while participating in game day party prepping, the big event, and after game celebrations/pity parties.

- 1 misdemeanor DUI arrests, 0 felony DUI Arrests
- 3 drivers charged with driving with a suspended or revoked license.
- 5 REDDIs reported with 2 drivers contacted and ultimately determined not to be DUI
- 2 damage only crashes 0 injury crashes and 0 fatal collision were investigated by troopers
- Of the 119 citations issued, 50 were issued for speeding and 7 issued for seatbelt or other occupant restraint violations
