COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 16 hour course is designed to provide a clear definition of the role of first responders in arson detection and provide essential knowledge to enable them to recognize the potential of intentionally set fires, preservation and protection of evidence, and proper reporting of the information to appropriate officials.

Target Audience: This course is designed for all fire and emergency services personnel who might conduct preliminary investigations into the origin and cause of fires.

PREREQUISITES:

1. Incident Command System (ISC)-100 and ISC-200 training. Preferred courses are Q0462 and Q0463, through NFA Online. Chief's signature attests that applicant has completed these.
2. Interested students are encouraged to complete Q0379 online prior to taking this class.
