<u>Anchorage:</u> May 5, 2017. The event starts at 3pm at the Alaska State Crime Detection Laboratory on 4805 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue.

<u>Juneau:</u> May 10, 2015. At noon there will be a wreath-laying at Evergreen Cemetery. At 6:00pm that evening there will be another ceremony at Dzantik'i Heeni Middle School.

<u>Fairbanks</u>: May 19, 2017. The event starts at 11am and is located at the Fairbanks Police Department at 911 Cushman Street.

*National Police Memorial Day is recognized on May 15 every year. Memorial services in Alaska are held on different days so families of the fallen officers can attend their local service as well as the National Memorial, if they choose.
