### Police Memorial Ceremonies

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska)- Alaska's Police Memorial Day will be celebrated this Friday May 10, 2013. To honor the 64 fallen Law Enforcement Officers from across the state, there will be multiple ceremonies at various locations.

**Anchorage:** May 10, 2013. The event starts at 3pm and is located in front of the Alaska State Crime Detection Laboratory at 4805 Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue

**Fairbanks:** May 15, 2013. The event starts at 11am and is located at the Fairbanks Police Department at 911 Cushman Street. Following the ceremony, FPD will host a picnic at their building.

**Juneau:** May 15, 2013. At noon there will be a wreath-laying at Evergreen Cemetery. At 6:00 pm there will be a ceremony in front of the Juneau Police Department. After that, there will be a partial showing of a documentary about fallen officers and their families inside JPD.

Please come and show your support to the men and women who wear a badge in order to make Alaska a safer, better place and to remember those who have lost their lives in the process.

\*National Police Memorial Day is recognized on May 15 every year. Alaska holds its main memorial service the Friday before the national memorial so families of the fallen officers can attend both events.
