The Alaska State Troopers will have a limited law enforcement presence at the 2016 Arctic Man event being held April 4-9.

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) – Commissioner Gary Folger, after consulting with the Governor’s Office, has agreed to provide law enforcement personnel in the best interests of keeping public safety a priority. Enhanced highway traffic enforcement will be in effect, along with search and rescue troopers on standby for immediate response in the event they are needed. Life/ death and high priority calls will be the primary mission.
