ACCUSATION

Irl T. Stambaugh, Administrator of the Police Standards Council, Department of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, moves to revoke the certificate of Robert J. Dutton, as a police officer pursuant to AS 18.65.240 (c), AS 18.65.270, AS 44.62.330 et. seq., 13 AAC 85.010 (a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110 (a)(1), and 13 AAC 85.110 (b)(3).

The Administrator Alleges as Follows:

1. On or about May 18, 1992, the respondent was hired as a police officer for the Anchorage Police Department, Anchorage, Alaska.
2. On or about February 9, 1993, the respondent submitted an application to the Alaska Police Standards Council (APSC) for a police officer certificate.
3. On or about March 5, 1993, the respondent was certified as a police officer in the State of Alaska.
4. On or about January 15, 2003, the Anchorage Police Department conducted an internal investigation into an allegation that the respondent falsified statistical information required to be

provided to the department while working a **federally funded traffic enforcement program**.

5. As a result of the internal investigation, the Department determined that the respondent provided false and misleading information.

6. On or about July 2, 2003, the Department's Internal investigation was concluded and the respondent was terminated from the Anchorage Police Department.

COUNT I

7. Paragraphs 1 through 6 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the administrator alleges that respondent was terminated for cause relating to misconduct, from employment as a police officer in Alaska, and therefore, his police officer certificate should be revoked under AS 18.65.240 (c), 13 AAC 85.110 (b)(3) and 13 AAC 85.110 (a)(1).

COUNT II

8. Paragraphs 1 through 7 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the administrator alleges that the conduct described in the forgoing paragraphs demonstrate that the respondent lacks good moral character. The respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240 (a) (2), 13 AAC 85.010 (a) (3), and 13


