ALL FEES are NON-Refundable

- Applications for certification will not be processed until the appropriate fee is received.
- Credit/Debit is preferred, otherwise check/money orders are payable to the Alaska Fire Standards Council.

DETAILED BREAKDOWN OF FEES

The Alaska Fire Standards Council has the following fee schedule in place for testing and certification:

\$25 Written Test- Single fee for tests taken during the same sitting (e.g. FFI & HMO)

\$25 Practical Test- Single fee for combined practical examinations (e.g. FFI & HMO)

\$25 Certificate Administration Fee - per certificate issued

Example – A firefighter testing for Firefighter I with Haz-Mat Aware/Ops will pay: \$100 Fee

- \$25 Written test FF I and Haz- Mat Aware/Ops
- \$25 Practical test FF I and Haz-Mat Aware/Ops

\$25 for Haz-Mat Aware/Ops Certificate

\$25 for FF I Certificate

\$25 Reciprocity – per certificate, up to the highest level within a single standard when evidence of each prerequisite level is clearly met.

Example 1 – The AFSC charges a single \$25 fee for Hazardous Materials Technician (NFPA 472) for requests that include certification documentation for Awareness, Operations, and Mission Specific 6.2 & 6.6). Upon approval the AFSC will recognize and record prerequisite levels in its database as "implied."

Example 2 – A firefighter requesting reciprocity for Firefighter II and Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations will pay \$25 for FF II written + \$25 for HMO = \$50 Fee (the AFSC records FFI as implied)

SUMMARY OF FINAL EXAM AND PROCESSING FEES BY CERTIFICATION TYPE

Common certification levels/requests:

\$100 Firefighter I with Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations with certificates (written/practical/admin)

\$75 Firefighter I ONLY with certificate (written/practical/admin)

\$75	Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations ONLY with certifications	cate (written/practical/admin)

- \$75 Fire Service Instructor, or Fire Officer, or other single levels with certificate (written/practical/admin)
- \$75 Fire Apparatus Driver Operator-Driver/Pumper (written/practical/admin)
- **\$75** Fire Apparatus Driver Operator-Aerial (written/practical/admin)
- **\$100** Fire Apparatus Driver Operator-MWS/Driver/Pumper (written/practical/admin)
- **\$100** Fire Apparatus Driver Operator-Driver/Pumper/Aerial (written/practical/admin)
- **\$125** Fire Apparatus Driver Operator-MWS/Driver/Pumper/Aerial (written/practical/admin)
- \$50 Written Test with ANY Renewal (written/admin)
- **\$25** Written Retest ONLY (any type) (*Non-refundable prepayment before retest request accepted.*)
- **\$25** Certification Renewal with no written exam (Fire Instructor, Fire Investigator)
- **\$25** Rural Fire Protection (Operations, Specialist)

\$15 Request for certificate copy (per copy with a maximum charge of \$30 per individual file, per each request)

\$10 State of Alaska *Firefighter I or II collar pins each (25% discount for 5 or more)

For Accredited programs the above fees will include all related seals | Collar pins will only be issued to AFSC certified FFI or FFII

FINAL EXAM AND PROCESSING FEES FOR REQUESTED EXAMINATIONS WITH LESS THAN 5 CANDIDATES

Actuals	*Direct expenses invoiced in lieu of individual test fees: CO cost, travel, parking, shipping (varies)
+20%	Administrative service fees (effective July 1, 2017)

*Fees for less than 5 candidates will be invoiced either as direct expenses OR individual test fees, whichever is greater.
