## THEREFORE the principal parties do hereby agree as follows:

- That the State of Arizona, by and through the Arizona Department of Public Safety, and the State of Alaska, will give full faith and credit to the concealed weapon permits issued by the respective states.
- 2. This agreement may be canceled upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party without penalty or further obligation.
- Any notice required to be given pursuant to this agreement will be made by registered mail
  to the Director, Arizona Department of Public Safety, 2102 West Encanto, Phoenix AZ.
  85009 and to the Commissioner, Alaska Department of Public Safety, 5700 East Tudor
  Road, Anchorage, AK. 99507.
- 4. This agreement is subject to cancellation pursuant to Arizona Revised Statue §38-511.
- All books, accounts, reports, files and other records relating to this Agreement shall be subject at all reasonable times to inspection and audit by either state for five (5) years after completion or termination of the Agreement as required by A.R.S. §35-214.
- The parties agree to comply with non-discrimination requirements of the federal government and their respective state.
- Any financing required for implementation will be sought through legislative appropriation
  by respective entities. The Agreement is subject to cancellation should necessary funding
  become unavailable.
- 8. This Agreement is effective when signed by authorized representatives of both states.
- 9. This Agreement will remain in effect until canceled.
- A copy of this Agreement will be filed with the Arizona Secretary of State.
- 11. This Agreement is not intended to limit or restrict the statutory authority or jurisdiction of either state; and if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected.
