



How to Set Up a Remote Written Test at PublicSafetyTesting.com

While Public Safety Testing (PST) has many tests already scheduled, there may not be one at a testing site or date/time that is convenient for you. In this case, you'll need to set up your own proctored test at a testing site nearby.

To do this, there is a specific, step-by-step process which will be detailed in this information sheet. Follow these steps very carefully, and if you have any trouble, reach out to PST for assistance:

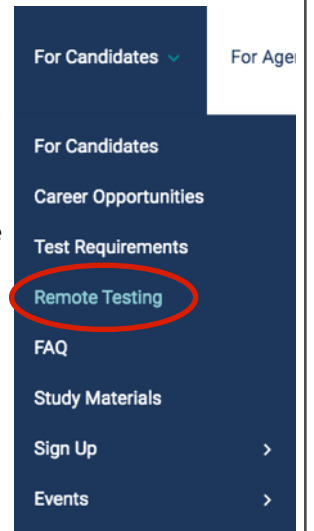

STEP ONE

Visit Public Safety Testing's Remote Testing Page

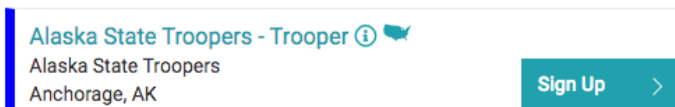
Surf over to PST's website and select the REMOTE TESTING link from the, "For Candidates" menu, read the information on that page, then click the signup button below:

STEP TWO

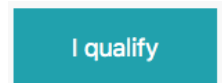
The next step is to add our agency to your test setup. Click the "Sign Up" button next to Alaska State Troopers to add us to your cart. This will change the button to show "Selected."



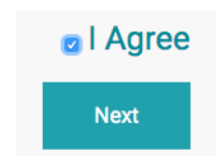
Then click the NEXT button in the upper right-hand corner of the page to move to the next screen.

STEP THREE

The next page will display the minimum qualifications for hire as an Alaska State Trooper. Read this carefully, then if you qualify, hit the, "I qualify" button in the lower right.



On the next page is the list of requirements and working conditions. If you agree, select, "I agree" then, "NEXT."



STEP FOUR

On the next page, you will see the option to schedule your written test. Click the, "Schedule Test" button. You do not need to worry about the physical fitness test at this time.

STEP SIX

Once you've selected your nearby testing center, you'll create your account with Public Safety Testing and pay the fee for your remote test. From your Dashboard, click on 'Remote Testing Registration' next to your event. You can view the final steps on this page and complete the necessary steps.

From here, there will only be a few additional steps for you to complete (uploading a notarized waiver and inputting your time and date into the website). PST will communicate with the testing center (they must also approve the date) and sends them the test materials.

FINAL STEP

Within a few days of completing your test, you'll receive your score. If you passed, you're eligible to apply to become an Alaska State Trooper! Go to www.alaskastatetrooper.com and click the "APPLY NOW" button.

STEP FIVE

On the next page, you'll have the option to search for nearby tests. If you cannot find a test near you, you'll select, "SHOW DETAILS" under the Remote Testing dialogue box. You'll need to accept the terms and conditions, then be directed to a map page where you can do a search for an eligible testing center near you.
