I put the new bottle in and it was leaking air when it was screwed in. I took the panel off and checked the o ring and it still was good and didn't seem messed up. I got a phone call a few days later saying there was a pump error code.

I went in there tonight and see that we have lost 300 psi in the past few days. I did a test on it and it worked fine. I made sure the bottle was on their good and when I touched it, it started leaking however so slight. I moved it a little and it stopped. Let me know if you think it just needs a new o ring and maybe send me one or tell me the size I need to buy.
