

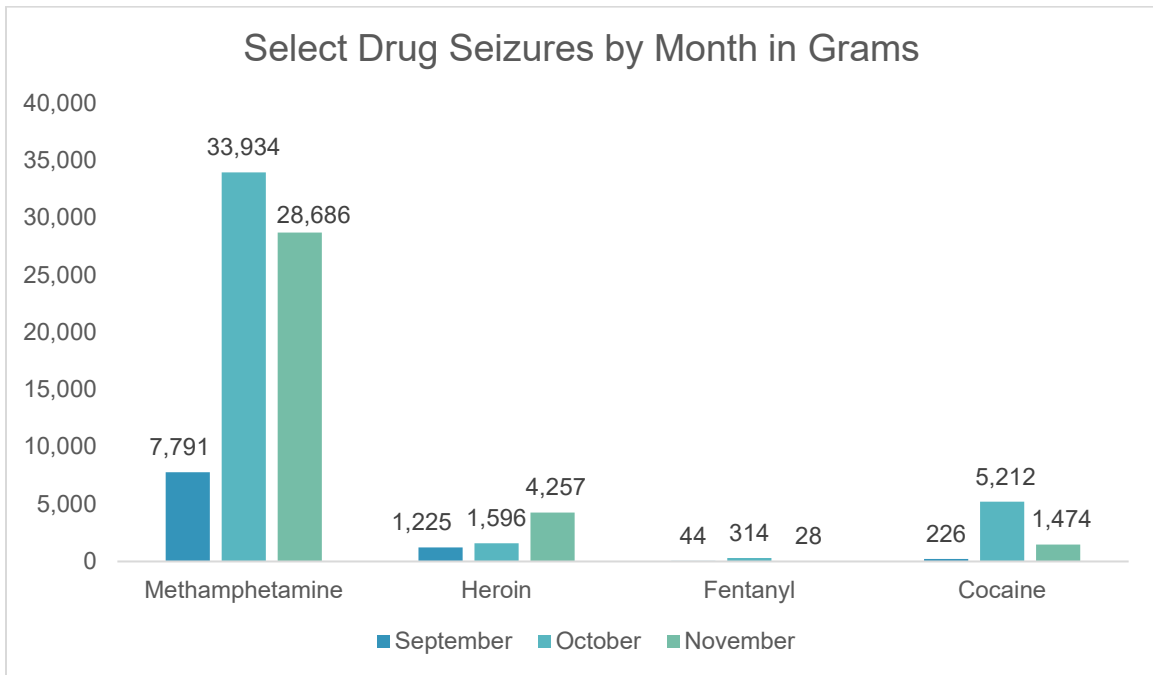

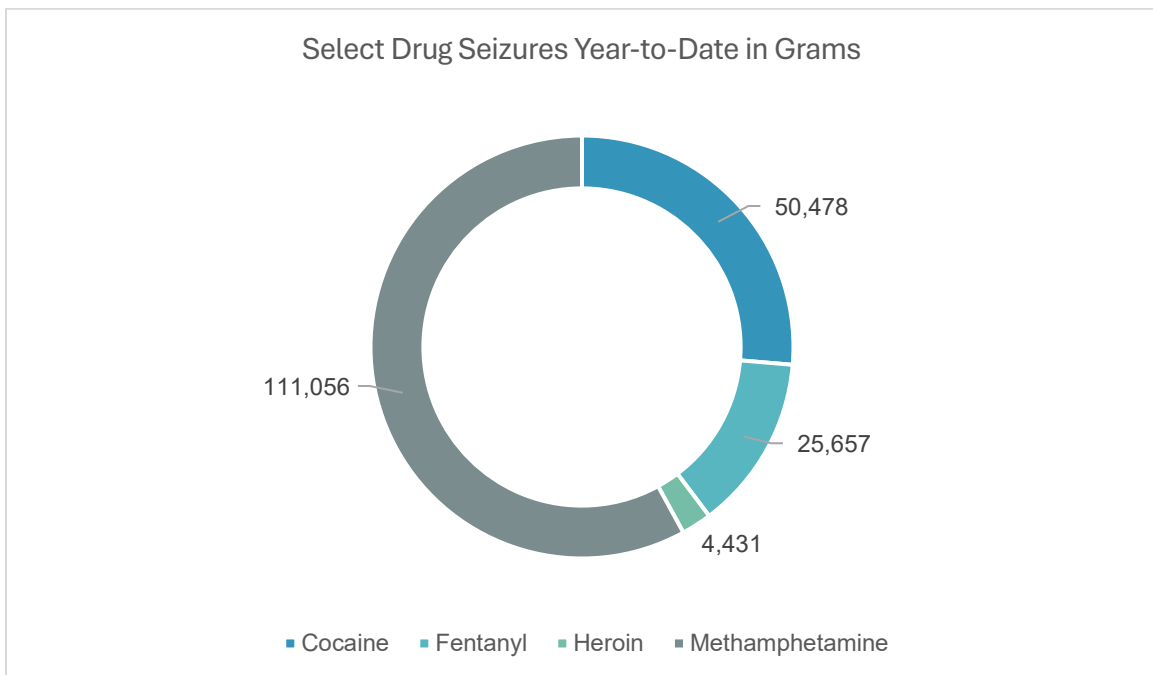

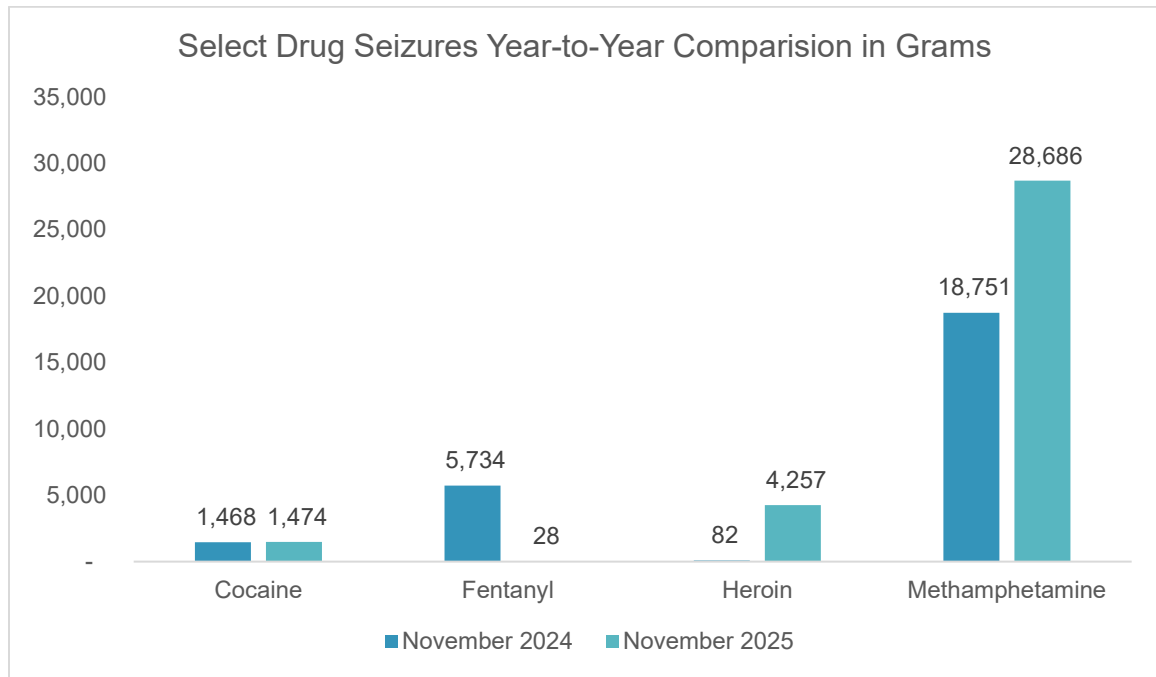
The accompanying charts provide an overview of preliminary drug and alcohol seizures by the Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit as of November 2025. The “Select Drug Seizures by Month in Grams” column chart shows a total of 84,787 grams seized.



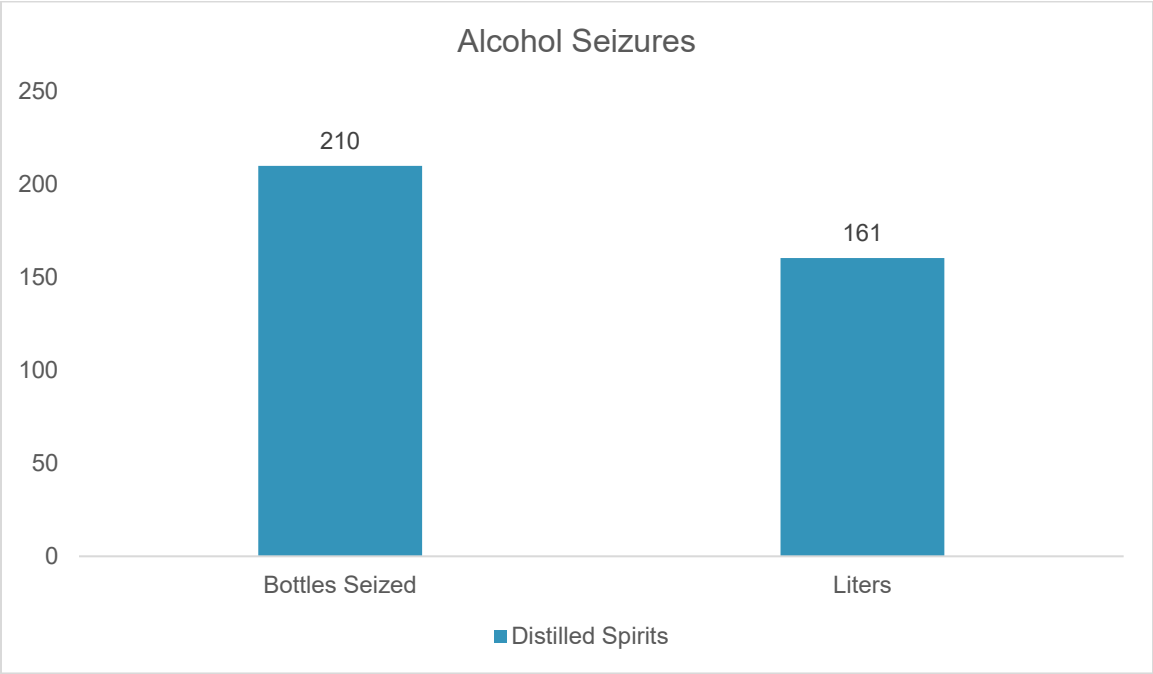
The “Select Drug Seizures Year-to-Date in Grams” pie chart shows methamphetamine as the most seized drug year-to-date.



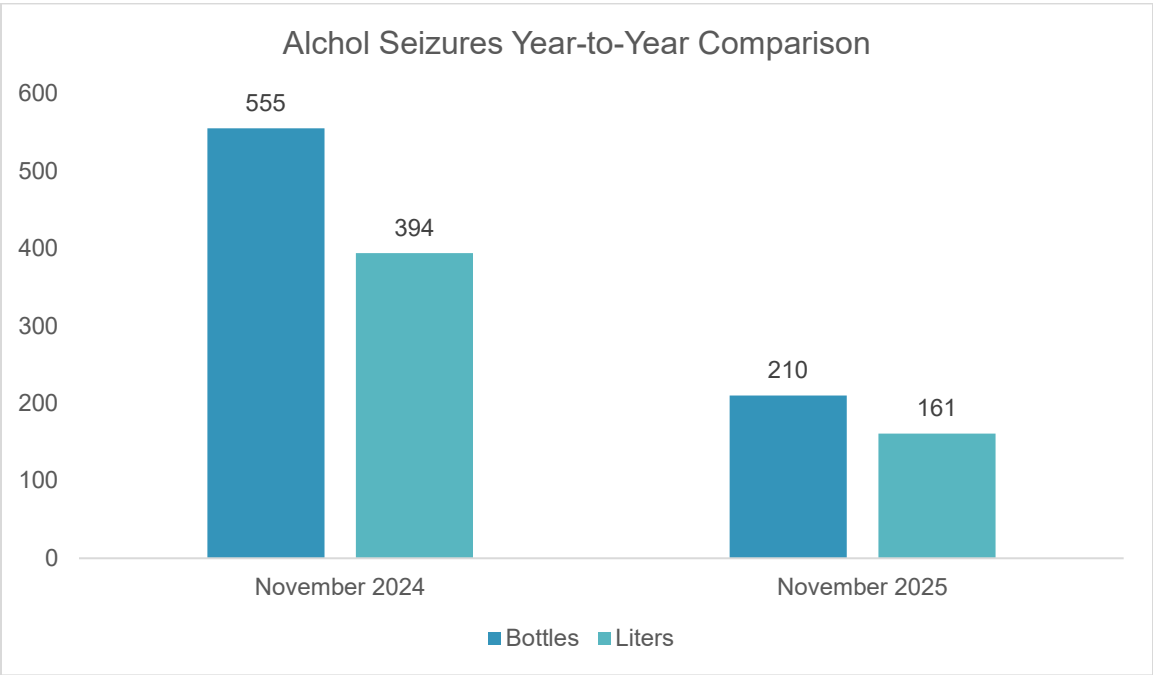
The “Select Drug Seizures Year-to-Year Comparison in Grams” column chart compares seizures for November 2024 to November 2025, demonstrating an 32% increase in total seizures. The chart reveals a significant decrease in the amount of fentanyl seizures, a 5,116% increase in the amount of heroin seizures, and a 53% increase in the amount of methamphetamine seizures in November 2025 compared to November 2024.



The “Alcohol Seizures” column chart breaks down alcohol seizures by total number of bottles and liters seized by alcohol type in November 2025.



The “Alcohol Seizures Year-to-Year Comparison” demonstrates a 62% decrease in bottles and 59% decrease in liters seized in November 2025 compared to November 2024.
