

## FBI Basic Crisis Negotiation Course

<u>Description</u>: Students will receive basic instruction on theory and practice to resolve hostage/barricade and suicide situations through proven crisis negotiation techniques. This 40-hour course is for individuals currently assigned to crisis negotiation teams, or who anticipate dealing with hostage/barricade situations in the course of their duty. Attendees must be sworn police/peace officers, correctional officers, eligible military personnel, mental health professionals, or tactical dispatchers sponsored by their department. Extensive role plays and team exercises are employed in this training.
