### **JUST 212 Criminal Procedure**

Students will be presented with an introductory examination of criminal procedures and how those procedures are applied by law enforcement agencies and criminal justice professionals. Emphasis upon the legal limitations of the police and the right of the people to be secure from the government under the protections of the United States Constitution and the Rules of Evidence. Prerequisite: JUST S110.

### **JUST 222 Research Methodology**

An introduction to the basic principles and techniques of social science research, including an overview of research methodology and ethical questions that arise as applicable to law enforcement. Specific methods and designs for conducting surveys, recording observations, and conducting appropriate experiments within the realm of social science. Students will study the great myths of American criminal justice and common knowledge. Prerequisite: JUST 110 recommended.

### **JUST S261 Ethics in Criminal Justice**

An examination of the ethical and moral concepts, and their relationship to criminal justice issues. This course applies ethics theories to the criminal justice institutions of police, courts and corrections. Examines ethical and moral dilemmas which confront law enforcement officers and crime control policy makers. 3 credits. Offered by distance learning. Prerequisite: None.
