You must have your supervisor's approval, prior to emailing Ms. Tovsen. The Basic Methodology course is online and will take 16-20 hours to complete.

Option 2: If you are applying only for the Practical Application course, please email Ms. Tovsen (stephanie.tovsen@alaska.gov). You must have your supervisor's approval prior to emailing Ms. Tovsen. We must have your *Basic Methodology* certificate on file before your application is considered.

If accepted into either of the courses, you will be notified by email. DPS has funds to cover all course fees and limited funds to support travel to the Practical Application course. Do not book travel until you receive an acceptance email.
