11 **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

14 In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above-captioned matter,
15 consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the
16 Alaska Police Standards Council, and pursuant to AS 18.65.220, AS18.65.242, 13 AAC
17 85.110, and 13 AAC 85.270, the undersigned parties enter into this Consent Agreement
18 as a final disposition of this matter.
19

20 1. Respondent, Jeremy James, without admitting any allegations that may have
21 been made against him/her, hereby permanently relinquishes their Alaska
22 police/probation/parole/correctional or municipal correctional officer certification;
23

24 2. Respondent waives their right to a hearing and waives the requirement of
25 Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for the Decision and Order below to be effective
26 and final;

28 3. Respondent waives any appeal or judicial review of the action agreed to herein;

29 4. Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards Council agree that this voluntary
30 relinquishment of certification shall permanently bar Respondent from working as a
31 police/probation/parole/correctional or municipal correctional officer in Alaska pursuant
32 to 13 AAC 85.010, 13 AAC 85.210, 13 AAC 85.215, and/or 13 AAC 89.010, but this
agreement shall have no effect upon any certification other than certification as a
police/probation/parole/correctional or municipal correctional officer;

5. Notwithstanding Paragraph 4, Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards

1 Council agree that Respondent shall retain their right to petition the Alaska Police
2 Standards Council for discretionary rescission of the revocation, as provided in 13 AAC

6 represented by an attorney concerning this Agreement and any potential Alaska Police
7 Standards Council proceedings. Respondent agrees that this Agreement was not signed
8 under duress and that he/she has had adequate time to consult with counsel or other
9 persons of their choosing;

11 7. Respondent understands that the public records law and open meetings law
12 apply to the Alaska Police Standards Council. Nothing in this agreement shall be
13 interpreted to accord more secrecy to the records of the Alaska Police Standards Council
14 beyond the confidentiality that is already required by law.
