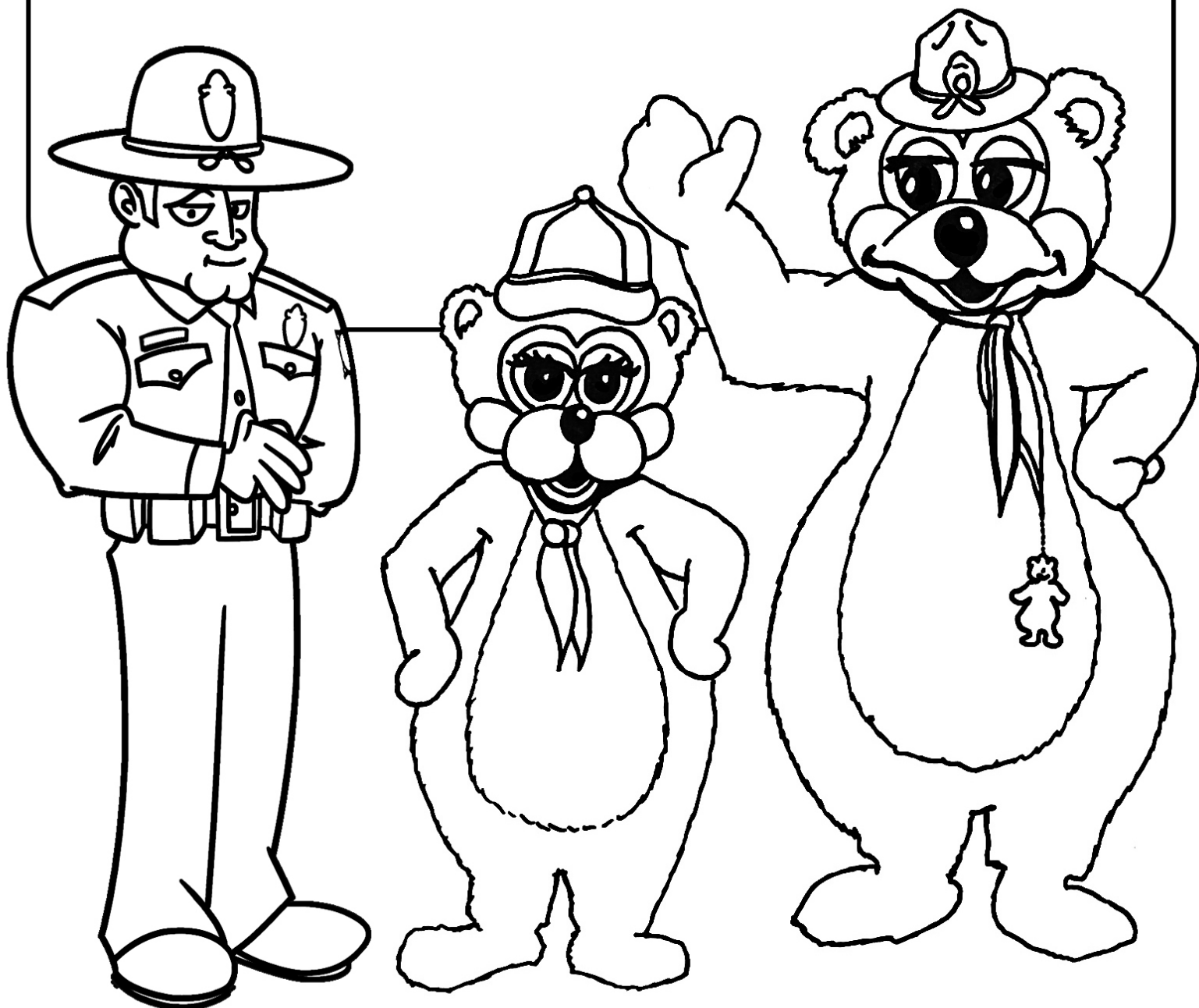

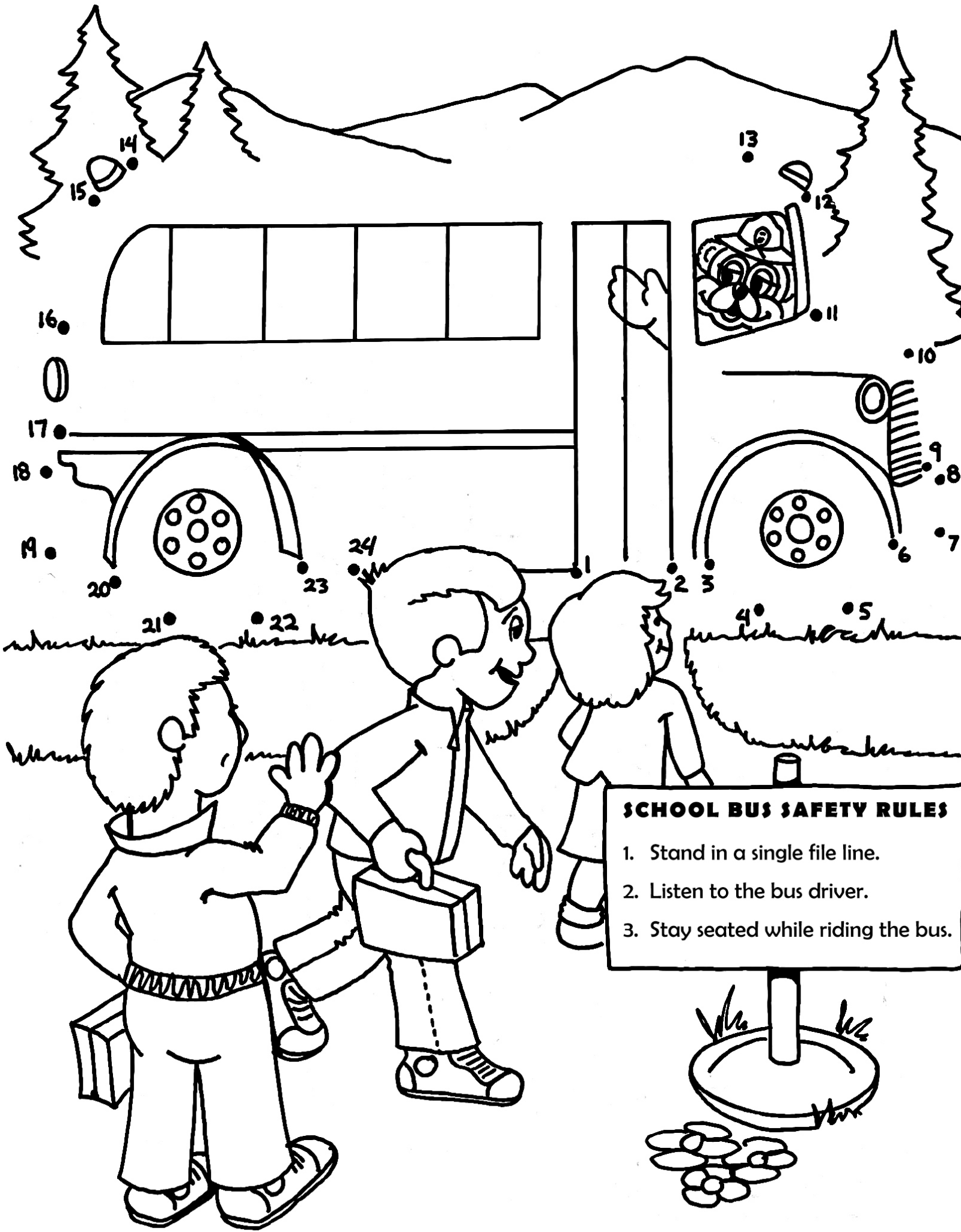
Hi Kids!

Have a fun, safe school year!



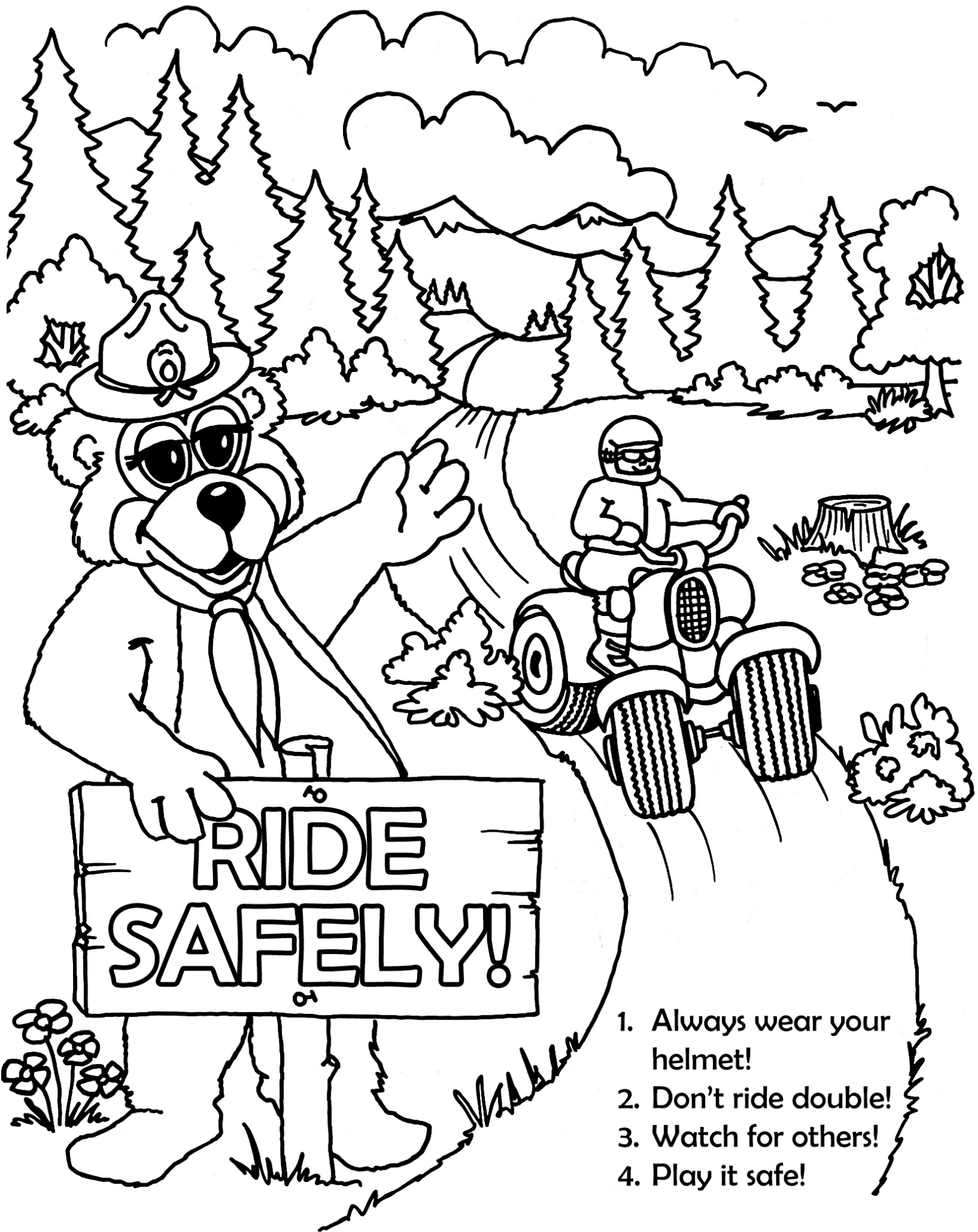


SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES

3. Stay seated while riding the bus.

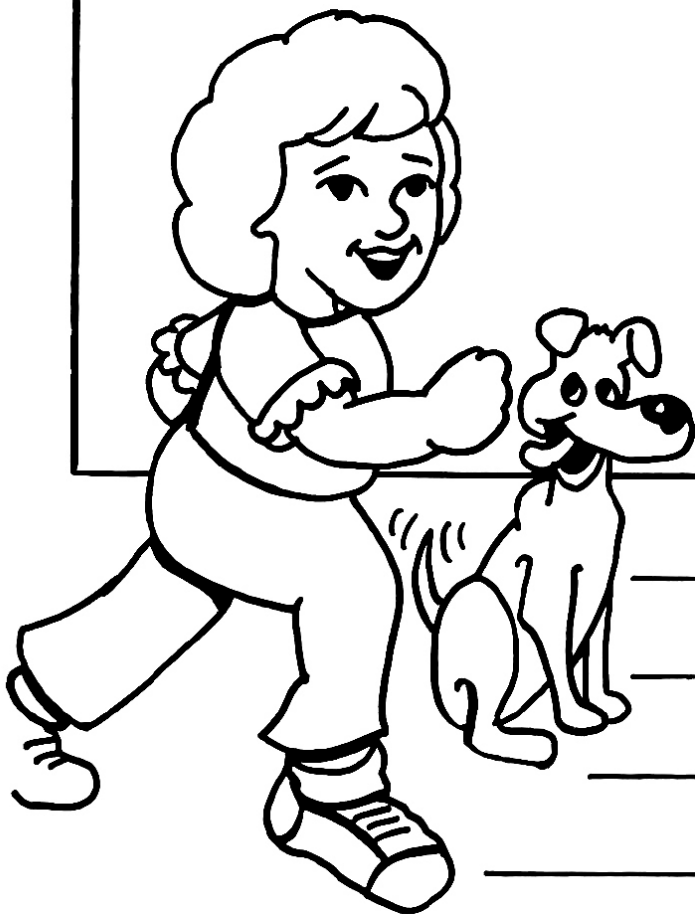
BUCKLE UP!

Stay away from thin ice!



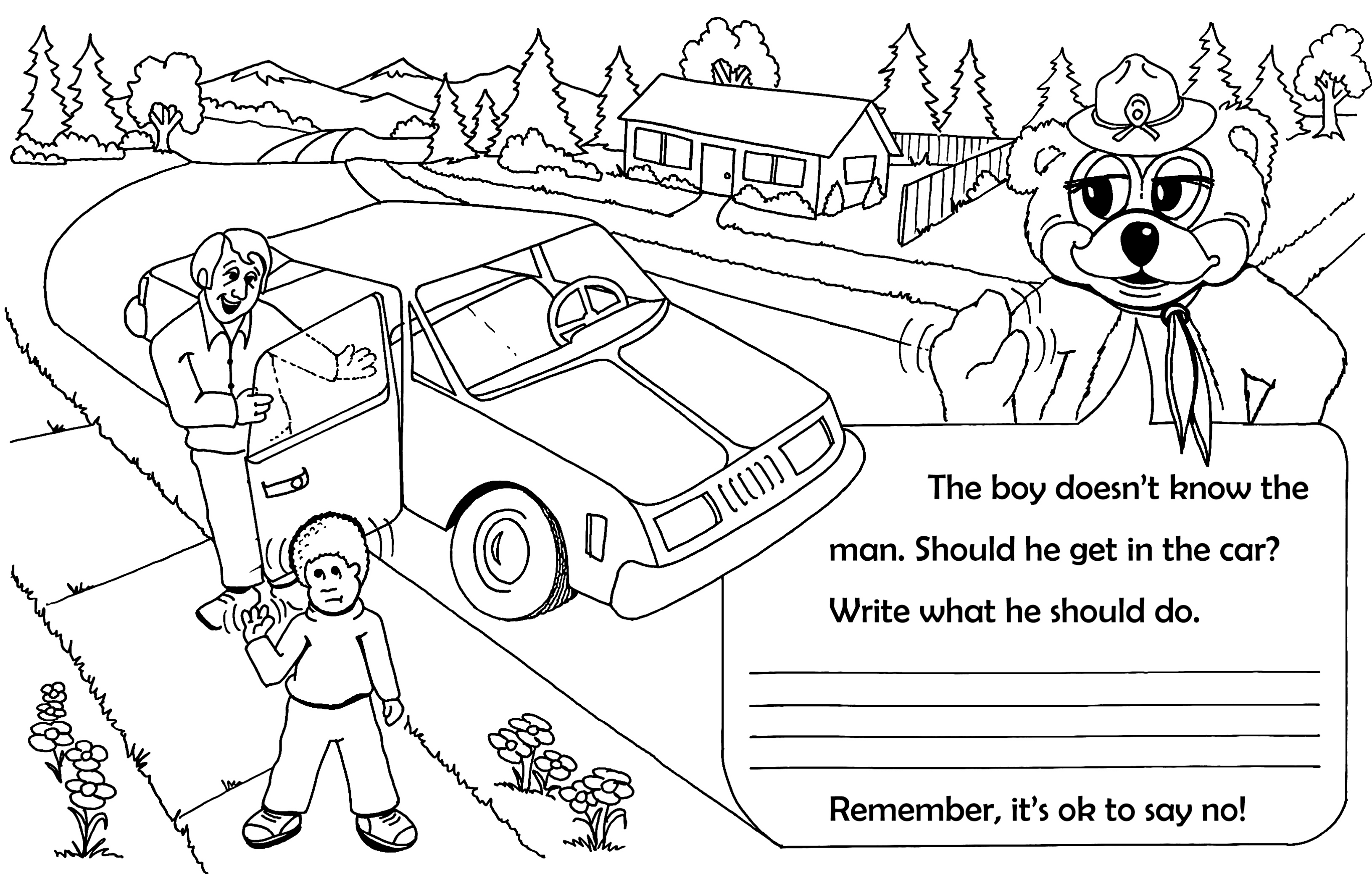
Your body belongs to you.



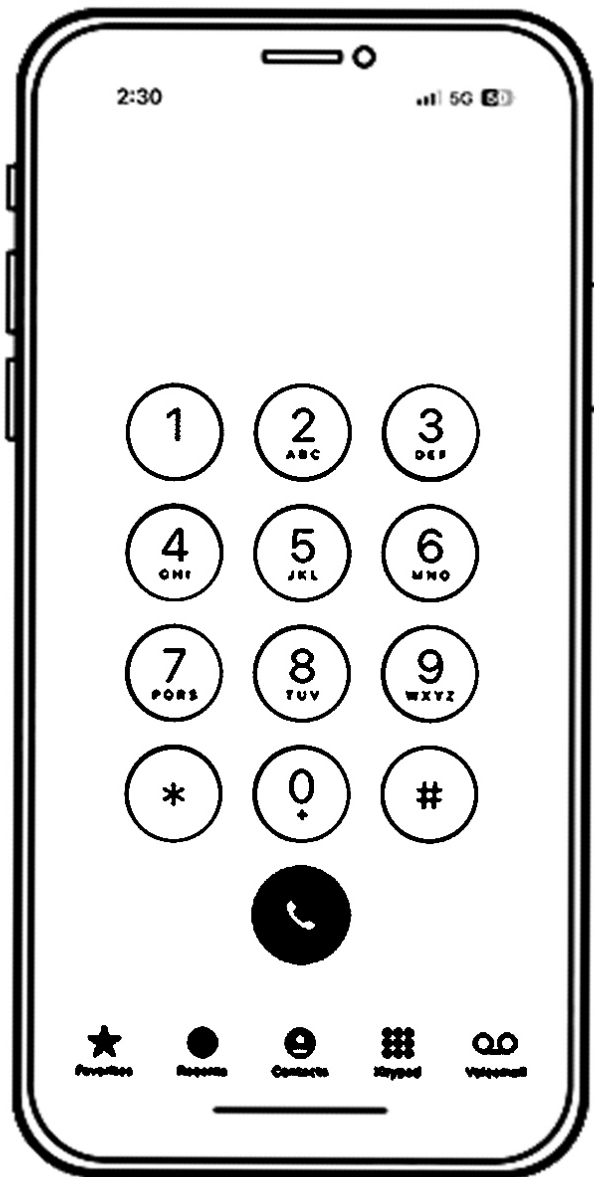


Dress warm and wear your reflector

Make sure the smoke detector works!! Ask Mom and Dad to check it. They know how.

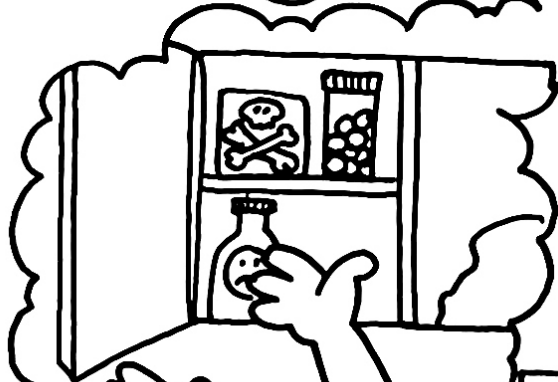
