Safety Tips

- Have your furnace inspected and serviced by a qualified professional.
- Have your chimney cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional.
- Only dry, seasoned wood should be used for your wood stove or fireplace.
- Children and pets should stay at least 3 feet away from any heating device.
- Heating appliances should be at least 3 feet from other flammables.
- Ensure that portable space heaters are plugged directly into an outlet.
- Space heaters should have an automatic shut-off safety device.
- Test and make sure you have working smoke alarms.
- Test and make sure you have working Carbon monoxide detectors.
