Get Ahead of the Winter Freeze

It's not too early to begin preparing for the heating season. It is a best practice to not procrastinate and gamble with the reliability of your heating appliances, smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. The following Safety tips will help you accomplish this:

Safety Tips

- ♦ Have your furnace inspected and serviced by a qualified professional.
- ♦ Have your chimney cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional.
- ♦ Only dry, seasoned wood should be used for your wood stove or fireplace.
- ♦ Children and pets should stay at least 3 feet away from any heating device.
- ♦ Heating appliances should be at least 3 feet from other flammables.
- ♦ Ensure that portable space heaters are plugged directly into an outlet.
- Space heaters should have an automatic shut-off safety device.
- ♦ Test and make sure you have working smoke alarms.
- ♦ Test and make sure you have working Carbon monoxide detectors.
