#### AFFIDAVIT OF LADDIE SHAW

Laddie Shaw, being first duly sworn upon oath, here deposes and states that:

A: I am employed as Administrator for the Alaska Police Standards Council (hereafter: Council).

B: As Administrator, my duties include the investigation of allegations and, when appropriate, the filing of an accusation which may result in the revocation of police certificates.

C: I have conducted an investigation into the matter of Peter P. Sheairs. Based upon the results of that investigation, and upon documents and records contained in council files, it is my information and belief that:

1. On or about May 19, 1986, the respondent was hired as a police officer for the Anchorage Police Department.

2. On or about June 23, 1987, the respondent signed an application for certification, requesting the Alaska Police Standards Council to approve issuance of a basic police officer certificate.

3. On or about July 10, 1991, the respondent was certified as a police officer in the State of Alaska.

4. On or about April 12, 1991, the respondent was dispatched to investigate an accident in the Port Area. As a result of respondent's handling of the investigation and preparation of reports detailing the incident, a complaint was filed and an internal investigation was initiated by the Anchorage Police Department.

5. On or about November 15, 1991, a complaint summary was filed by Captain George Novaky, Anchorage Police Department

alleging that respondent violated Anchorage Police Department Regulations 1.02.000, 1.03.035, 1.03.065, 1.03.075 and 1.03.160.

6. On or about November 15, 1991, the respondent's employment as a police officer for the Anchorage Police Department was terminated for cause based on findings that respondent violated the following Anchorage Police Department Regulations: 1.03.160-Documents to be Accurate, 1.03.065-Performance of Duty, 1.03.075-Equal Enforcement, 1.02.000-the Law Enforcement Code of Ethics and 1.03.035-Obeying a Lawful Order.

D: On April 15, 1993, Jack Wray, then Administrator of the Council sent to the respondent by U.S. mail, return receipt requested, documents consisting of an Accusation, Statutes of the Alaska Police Standards Council, Regulations of the Alaska Police Standards Council, the Administrative Procedures Act, and a Notice of Defense. The Accusation contained the allegations shown as numbered paragraphs 1-6.

E: On April 21, 1993, a United States Postal Service "Return Receipt," was received by the Council signed with the name "Peter P. Sheairs," the date of delivery block was postmarked April 19, 1993. A copy of the Return Receipt is attached to this affidavit.

F: The Notice of Defense and the letter dated April 6, 1993 sent to the respondent contains instructions that the Notice must be filed with the Council within 15 days of receipt.

G: The 15 day period during which respondent could have filed a Notice of Defense expired on May 7, 1993. As of the date of this Affidavit, no Notice of Defense has ever been received from the respondent.

H: I conclude that the conduct described in numbered paragraphs 4-6 demonstrates that the respondent lacks good moral character, and that respondent resigned from his employment as a police officer in lieu of being discharged. Respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), and under AS 18.65.240(c), 13 AAC 85.110(a)(2), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3), his police officer certificate must be revoked.

### ACCUSATION

Jack W. Wray, Administrator of the Police Standards Council, Department of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, moves to revoke the certification of Peter P. Sheairs, as a police officer pursuant to AS 18.65.240(a)(2), AS 18.65.240(c), AS 18.65.270, AS 44.62.330 <u>et. seq.</u>, 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), 13 AAC 85.110(a)(2), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3).

The Administrator alleges as follows:

1. On or about May 19, 1986, the respondent was hired as a police officer for the Anchorage Police Department.

2. On or about June 23, 1987, the respondent signed an application for certification, requesting the Alaska Police Standards Council to approve issuance of a basic police officer certificate.

3. On or about July 10, 1987, the respondent was certified as a police officer in the State of Alaska.

4. On or about April 12, 1991, respondent was dispatched to investigate an accident in the Port Area. As a result of respondent's handling of the investigation and preparation of reports detailing the incident, a complaint was filed and an internal investigation was initiated by the Anchorage Police Department.

5. On or about November 15, 1991, a complaint summary was filed by Captain George Novaky, Anchorage Police Department alleging that respondent violated Anchorage Police Department Regulations 1.02.000, 1.03.035, 1.03.065, 1.03.075 and 1.03.160.

### Count I

7. Paragraphs 1 through 6 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges conduct described in that the paragraphs 4-6 demonstrates that respondent lacks good moral character. The respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3), and his police officer certificate should be revoked.

## Count II

8. Paragraphs 1 through 6 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that the respondent was discharged, for cause, from his employment as a police officer for the Anchorage Police Department, and therefore his police officer certificate should be revoked under AS 18.65.240(a)(2) and 13 AA 85.110(a)(2).

WHEREFORE, the Administrator prays that Peter P. Sheairs' certificate as a police officer in the State of Alaska be revoked.
