10 **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

11 In the interest of prompt and speedy settlement of the above-captioned matter, with the  
12 public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the Alaska Police Standards  
13 Council, and pursuant to AS 18.65.220, AS 18.65.240 and 13 AAC 85.110, the undersigned  
14 parties enter into this Consent Agreement as a final disposition of this matter.

15 1. Respondent, without admitting any allegations that may have been made against  
16 him, hereby permanently relinquishes his Alaska police officer certification, issued pursuant to  
17 13 AAC. 85.040;

18 2. Respondent waives his right to a hearing and waives the requirement of Findings  
19 of Fact and Conclusions of Law for the Decision and Order below to be effective and final;

20 3. Respondent waives any appeal or judicial review of the action agreed to herein;


21 4. Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards Council agree that this voluntary  
22 relinquishment shall permanently bar respondent from working as a police officer in Alaska  
23 pursuant to 13 AAC 85.010 – 13 AAC 85.120, but this agreement shall have no effect upon any  
24 certification other than certification as a police officer pursuant to 13 AAC 85.110;


25 5. Notwithstanding paragraph 4, Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards  
26 Council agree that the Respondent shall retain his right to petition the council for discretionary  
27 rescission of the revocation after he has completed the probation imposed by the Superior Court  
28 in case no. 4FA-08-2905 CR, which, regardless of any other agreement, will not occur not less



2 than one year after the entry of this order, provided that the Respondent follows the procedure  
3 and standards set out in 13 AAC 85.110(d)(1)-(3);


4 5. Respondent understands that he has the right to consult with and be represented by  
5 an attorney concerning this Agreement and any potential Alaska Police Standards Council  
6 proceedings. He avows that he either already has or does now waive the right to an attorney.  
7 Respondent agrees that this Agreement was not signed under duress and that he has had  
8 adequate time to consult with counsel or other persons of his choosing;

9 6. Respondent understands that the public records law and open meetings law apply  
10 to the Alaska Police Standards Council. Nothing in this agreement shall be interpreted to accord  
11 more secrecy to the records of the Alaska Police Standards Council beyond the confidentiality  
12 that is already required by law.

**DECISION AND ORDER**
