QUALIFICATIONS:	Must meet Alaska Police Standards Council basic standards for police officers and chiefs. Bachelor's Degree in criminal justice, business or public administration or a related field; Six (6) years of police command experience OR and equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
WORKING ENVIRONMENT:	Work is performed in an office and field setting. Travel is required to locations throughout the City; exposure to adverse environmental conditions, bio hazards and life-threatening conditions.
PHYSICAL DEMANDS:	Mobility to work in an office setting, use standard office equipment and stamina to sit, stand, walk for extended periods of time; agility to traverse uneven terrain; strength to lift and carry up to 50 pounds; vision to read printed materials and computer screens; and hearing and speech to communicate in person or over the telephone.
