ORDER

The Alaska Police Standards Council (hereafter: Council) of the State of Alaska, having duly convened on the 25th of September 1985, and having reviewed and discussed the Accusation against the respondent which was served June 11, 1985 in accordance with AS 44.62.380, takes official notice that a Notice of Defense or a Request for Hearing has not been received from respondent as required by AS 44.62.390. The Council also takes official notice that, under AS 44.62.530, if the respondent does not file a Notice of Defense, the Council may take action based upon other evidence, and an Affidavit may be used as evidence without notice to the respondent.

Accordingly, the Council has considered the attached Affidavit of Jack W. Wray, Administrator of the Council.

Based upon the Council's consideration of the facts recited in Mr. Wray's Affidavit, including attached court documents:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the allegations made in the Accusation against respondent dated June 6, 1985 are hereby adopted; the Accusation is made by reference a part of this Order as though set forth fully herein.

2. That respondent's police officer certificate in the State of Alaska is hereby revoked.


3. This Order of Revocation shall take effect in accordance with AS 44.62.520(a).

ACCUSATION

Jack W. Wray, Administrator of the Alaska Police Standards Council of the State of Alaska, moves to revoke the certificate of William F. Walker as a police officer pursuant to AS 18.65.240(a)(2), AS 18.65.240(c), AS 18.65.270, AS 44.62.330 et. sec., 13 AAC 85.100(a)(4), and former 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3).

The Administrator alleges as follows:

1. On or about May 19, 1983, respondent was hired as a police officer for the Seward Police Department, Seward, Alaska.
2. On or about July 24, 1984, respondent submitted an application to the Alaska Police Standards Council (APSC) for a basic police officer certificate.
3. On or about August 23, 1984, APSC issued respondent a basic certificate as a police officer in the State of Alaska.
4. On or about the months of February of 1983, and April or May of 1983, the respondent did unlawfully engage in sexual contact with a child under 16 years of age but 13 years of age or older, by touching the child's genitals.
5. On or about August 29, 1984, respondent confessed to engaging in sexual contact with a child under 16 years of age but 13 years of age or older, by touching the child's genitals once during the month of February of 1983 and once during either the month of April or May of 1983.
6. On or about September 7, 1984, respondent was charged with one count of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor (former AS 11.51.130(a)(4)), a class A misdemeanor, in the Superior Court of the State of Alaska, Third Judicial District, Kenai, Alaska.

7. On or about September 7, 1984, respondent resigned from the Seward Police Department.


8. On or about December 4, 1984, respondent plead no contest to one count of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor (former AS 11.51.130), a class A misdemeanor, and was sentenced by the court.

COUNT I

9. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that the conduct described in paragraphs 4 through 8 demonstrates that the respondent lacks good moral character. Respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), former 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4), and former 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3), and his police officer certificate should be revoked.

Wherefore, the Administrator prays that the certificate of William F. Walker as a police officer in the State of Alaska be revoked.
