- What:** Statewide Sexual Assault Response Team training.
- Where:** BP Energy Center in Anchorage, AK
- When:** March 17 - 20, with March 20 as a discipline-specific training day. Each day will begin at 7:45am with registration. Training will begin at 8am and end at 5pm each day, with lunch and breaks scheduled.
- Who:** Attendees should be members of or affiliated with an active, functioning SART team, representing either advocacy, medical, law enforcement, or prosecution.
- Notes:** This training is being jointly provided by the Alaska Nurses Association (AaNA) and the Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault (CDVSA). There is no registration fee. As a state-sponsored training, CDVSA will cover travel and lodging costs for accepted applicants traveling in from greater than 50 miles from the training site. These costs include ground and/or air travel, as well as lodging. Per diem is not covered. CDVSA will not cover any travel/lodging costs for participants within 50 miles of the training site. More details will come regarding how to arrange travel and lodging. **Please await instructions on booking travel/lodging.**

This “Save the Date” is to announce the upcoming SART training and to give enough detail to allow for potential attendees to make necessary arrangements within their agencies. The CDVSA will provide a registration link on our events page (cdvsa.eventsmart.com) by **January 10, 2020** for potential attendees to apply for this training.
