7 ACCUSATION

8 James F. Mayer, Administrator of the Alaska Police Standards
9 Council, Department of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, moves to
10 revoke the certificate of Gregory M. Olson as police officer pursuant
11 to the provisions of AS 18.65.240(c), AS 18.65.270, AS 44.62.330 et. seq.,
12 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3) and 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4). The Administrator alleges
13 as follows:

14 1. On or about June 14, 1979, respondent was certified as
15 a police officer in the State of Alaska, while employed by the Peterburg
16 Police Department.

17 2. On or about November 15, 1980, respondent became employed
18 by the Bethel Police Department.

19 3. On or about March 27, 1982, respondent forced his way into
20 a private residence at 98 Baranof Street, Fairbanks, Alaska.

21 4. At the time of his forced entry into the residence at 98
22 Baranof Street the respondent was extremely intoxicated, identified
23 himself as a police officer, and displayed a police badge.

24 5. On or about March 27, 1982, respondent assaulted George
25 Pharr at 98 Baranof Street, Fairbanks, Alaska.

26 6. On or about March 27, 1982, respondent assaulted Mark Hann,
27 a Yellow Cab driver, in Fairbanks, Alaska.

28 7. On or about May 1, 1982, respondent's employment as a police
29 officer with the Bethel Police Department was terminated for cause.

30 8. On or about June 24, 1982, in the District Court for the
31 State of Alaska, Fourth Judicial District at Fairbanks, Alaska, respon-
32 dent was found guilty after a court trial of: Count I - Criminal Trespass

1 in the 1st Degree (the court judgement apparently erroneously indicates
2 that this offense was Criminal Trespass in the 4th Degree); Count II -
3 Assault in the 4th Degree; and Count III - Assault in the 4th Degree.
4 All of these offenses are class A misdemeanors. Imposition of sentence
5 was suspended and respondent was placed on probation until June 24, 1985.
6 Respondent was ordered to pay all costs for medical care incurred by
7 either or both victims of the assaults.

8 COUNT I


9 8. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated herein by reference
10 as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges
11 that respondent's certificate as a police officer may be revoked because
12 his conduct as setout in paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 falls below the
13 minimum standards for certified police officers under AS 18.65.240(a)(2)
14 and 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4).

15 COUNT II

16 9. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated herein by reference
17 as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges
18 that respondent's discharge for cause from the Bethel Police Department
19 constitutes grounds for revocation of his police officer certificate
20 pursuant to 13 AAC 85.100(a)(2).

21 Wherefore, the Administrator prays that the certificate of
22 Gregory M. Olson as a police officer in the State of Alaska be revoked.
