## COUNT I

8. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that respondent's certificate as a police officer may be revoked because his conduct as setout in paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 falls below the minimum standards for certified police officers under AS 18.65.240(a)(2) and 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4).

## COUNT II

9. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that respondent's discharge for cause from the Bethel Police Department constitutes grounds for revocation of his police officer certificate pursuant to 13 AAC 85.100(a)(2).

Wherefore, the Administrator prays that the certificate of Greggory M. Olson as a police officer in the State of Alaska be revoked. Dated this  $\frac{7}{1-4}$  day of January, 1983.
