CONSENT AGREEMENT

In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above-captioned matter, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements, and the responsibilities of the Alaska Police Standards Council ("APSC"), and pursuant to AS 18.65.220, AS 18.65.242, 13 AAC 85.110, and 13 AAC 85.270, the undersigned parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") as a final disposition of this matter.

1. Pursuant to this Agreement, Respondent, Robert Carlson, without admitting any allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter on or about September 27, 2018, hereby permanently relinquishes his Alaska Probation & Parole Officer Certification ("Certification"), effective June 1, 2021 (hereinafter "Effective Date").

2. Pursuant to this Agreement, Respondent waives his right to a hearing before the Office of Administrative Hearings in OAH No. 18-1040-POC and

waives the requirement for Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for the Decision and Order below to be effective and final.

3. Respondent waives any appeal or judicial review of this Agreement or the Decision and Order agreed to herein.

4. Respondent and APSC agree that Respondent's voluntary relinquishment of certification shall permanently bar Respondent from working as a police/probation/parole/correctional and/or municipal correctional officer in Alaska pursuant to 13 AAC 85.210, 13 AAC 85.210, 13 AAC 85.215, and/or 13 AAC 89.010, but that this Agreement shall have no effect upon any certification other than certification as a police/probation/parole/correctional and/or municipal correctional officer.

5. Notwithstanding Paragraph 4, Respondent and APSC agree that Respondent shall retain his right to petition the APSC for discretionary rescission of the revocation, as provided in 13 AAC 270(d)(3), after the Effective Date.

6. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with and be represented by an attorney regarding this Agreement and any potential APSC proceedings. Respondent has had adequate time to consult with counsel and other persons of his choosing regarding this Agreement. Respondent has not signed this Agreement under duress. Rather, Respondent has entered into this Agreement knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently.

7. Respondent understands and acknowledges that Alaska's Public Record Act (AS 40.25.110-295) and Alaska's Open Meetings Act (AS 44.62.310-312)

apply to the APSC. Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted to accord more secrecy to the records of the APSC beyond the provisions that are required by law.
