ORDER

The Alaska Police Standards Council (hereafter: Council) of the State of Alaska, having duly convened on the 13th day of March, 1986, and having reviewed and discussed the Accusation against the respondent which was served on December 12, 1985 in accordance with AS 44.62.380, takes official notice that a Notice of Defense or a Request for Hearing has not been received from respondent as required by AS 44.62.390. The Council also takes official notice that, under AS 44.62.530, if the respondent does not file a Notice of Defense, the Council may take action based upon other evidence, and an Affidavit may be used as evidence without notice to the respondent.

Accordingly, the Council has considered the attached Affidavit of Jack W. Wray, Administrator of the Council.

Based upon the Council's consideration of the facts recited in Mr. Wray's Affidavit:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. That the allegations made in the Accusation against respondent dated December 6, 1985 are hereby adopted; the Accusation is made by reference a part of this Order as though set forth fully herein.


2. That respondent's police officer certificate in the State of Alaska is hereby revoked.

3. That this Order of Revocation shall take effect in accordance with AS 44.62.520(a).

7 Accusation

8 Jack W. Wray, Administrator of the Alaska Police
9 Standards Council of the State of Alaska, moves to revoke the
10 certificate of Jon W. Craig as a police officer pursuant to
11 AS 18.65.240(a)(2), AS 18.65.240(c), AS 18.65.270,
12 AS 44.62.330 et. sec., former 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), former
13 AAC 85.010(a)(4), former 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3),
14 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3), 13 AAC 85.110(b)(1).

15 The Administrator alleges as follows:

16 1. On or about March 24, 1980, respondent was
17 hired as a public safety officer for the North Slope Borough
18 Department of Public Safety, Barrow, Alaska.

19 2. On or about August 14, 1981, respondent
20 submitted an application to the Alaska Police Standards
21 Council (APSC) for a basic police officer certificate.

22 3. On or about October 26, 1981, APSC issued
23 respondent a basic certificate as a police officer in the
24 State of Alaska.

25 4. On or about March 23, 1984, respondent resigned
26 from employment with the North Slope Borough Department of
27 Public Safety.

28 5. On or about August 6, 1984, a Grand Jury in the
29 Second Judicial District, Kotzebue, Alaska, issued an
30 indictment charging respondent with three counts of Sexual
31 Abuse of a Minor in the Second Degree, in violation of
32 AS 11.41.436(a)(1), and with one count of Sexual Assault in
the First Degree, in violation of AS 11.41.410(a)(1).

6. On or about June 14, 1985, respondent entered a plea of no contest to Count I of the Indictment. That count charged that during the period from December 1983 through March 1984 respondent, age 35, engaged in sexual penetration on numerous occasions with a 14-year-old girl. This conduct violated AS 11.41.436(a)(1), Sexual Abuse of a Minor in the Second Degree, and is a class B felony offense.

7. On or about June 14, 1985, respondent was sentenced to a five-year term of imprisonment, with three of the five years suspended.

Count I

8. Paragraphs 1 through 7 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that the sexual conduct described in paragraph 6 demonstrates that respondent lacks good moral character. Respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), former 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4), former 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3), 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3), and his police officer certificate should be revoked.


Count II

9. Paragraphs 1 through 7 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), former 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), former 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110(b)(1), respondent's police officer certificate must be revoked because the respondent has been convicted of a felony.

Wherefore, the Administrator prays that Jon W. Craig's certificate as a police officer in the State of

Alaska be revoked.
