### APPLICATION FOR CERTIFYING OFFICER

# **I. Description and Application Process**

The Alaska Fire Standards Council utilizes Certifying Officers (CO's) to supervise and conduct certification testing in accordance with operational directives. This application is intended for individuals who meet the basic requirements and are interested in acquiring AFSC endorsement as a Certifying Officer.

Once approved, individuals will become eligible as CO Trainees and will be included in the active Certifying Officer notification procedure. Eligibility for CO assignments will be granted upon successful completion of training and final endorsement approval.

## II. Criteria for Initial Application as a Certifying Officer:

The CO candidate must meet all prerequisites **before** submitting this application:

# 1. Prerequisites

- Complete this Certifying Officer Application; and
- Current AFSC Fire Service Instructor:
  - o list expiration date ; and
- Read the Certifying Officer Manual in its entirety; and
- Attach a brief resume with 5 years' experience as an active firefighter/instructor that highlights instructor experience; and
  - o include three fire service references with email and contact number.

#### 2. Requisites

- Completion of an AFSC approved Certifying Officer workshop/seminar; and
- Completion of CO Exam worksheet with 100% accuracy; and
- Review and sign the CO Code of Ethics Compliance form.
