CONSENT AGREEMENT  
DECISION AND ORDER

**CONSENT AGREEMENT**

In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above-captioned matter, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the Alaska Police Standards Council, and pursuant to AS 18.65.220, AS18.65.242, 13 AAC 85.110, and 13 AAC 85.270, the undersigned parties enter into this Consent Agreement as a final disposition of this matter.

1. Respondent, David M Schofield, without admitting any allegations that may have been made against him, hereby permanently relinquishes his Alaska police officer certification;

2. Respondent maintains that he is permanently disabled and unable to meet the physical requirements of his police officer certification with the state of Alaska. He maintains he has no intent to seek re-employment as a police officer in the future due to his disability;

3. Respondent waives his right to a hearing and waives the requirement of Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for a Decision and Order below to be effective and final;

4. Respondent waives any appeal or judicial review of the action agreed to herein;

5. Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards Council agree that this voluntary relinquishment of certification shall permanently bar Respondent from working as a police/probation/parole/correctional or municipal correctional officer, which he

maintains is due to his permanent disability. This agreement shall have no effect upon any certifications other than his certification as a police/probation/parole/correctional or municipal correctional officer;


6. Notwithstanding Paragraph 5, Respondent and the Alaska Police Standards Council agree that Respondent shall retain his right to petition the Alaska Police Standards Council for discretionary rescission of this relinquishment of his certification, as provided in 13 AAC 85.270(d)(3);

7. Respondent understands that he has the right to consult with and be represented by an attorney concerning this Agreement. Respondent agrees that this Agreement was not signed under duress and that he/she has had adequate time to consult with counsel or other persons of their choosing;

8. Respondent understands that the public records law and open meetings law apply to the Alaska Police Standards Council. Nothing in this agreement shall be interpreted to accord more secrecy to the records of the Alaska Police Standards Council beyond the confidentiality that is already required by law.
