

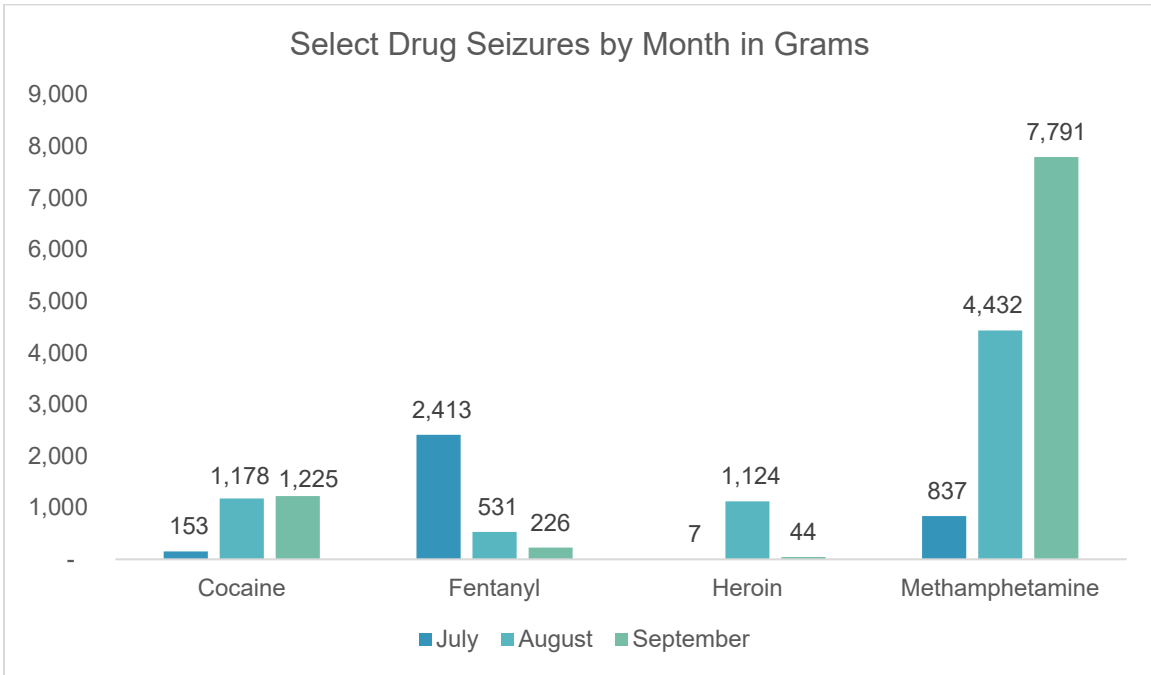

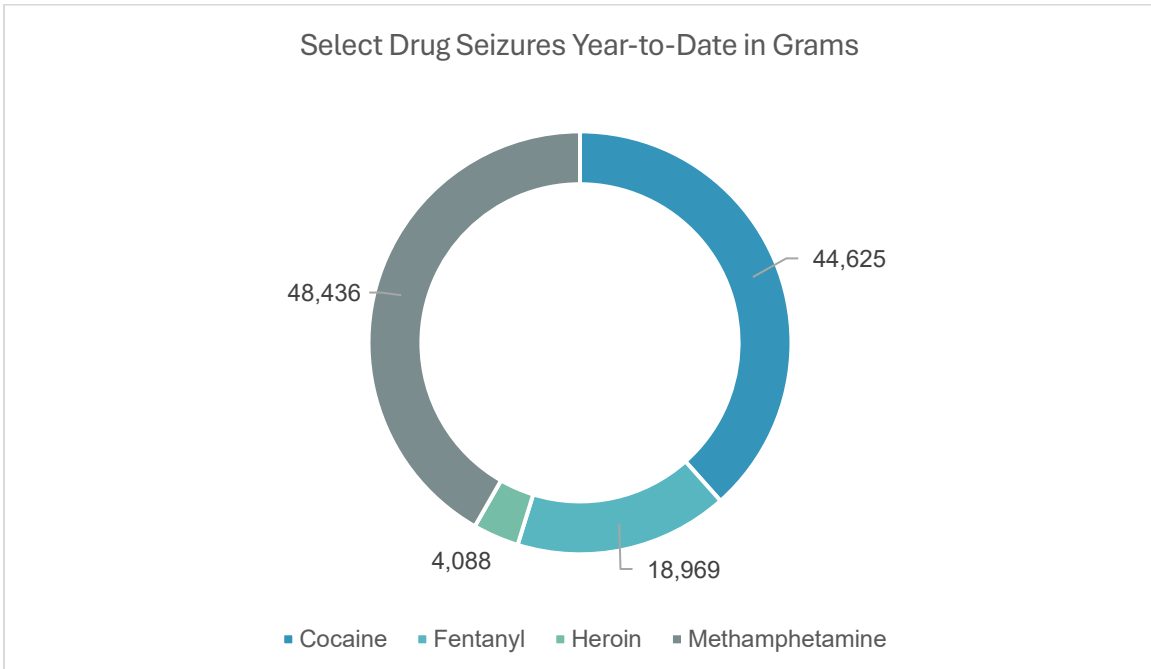

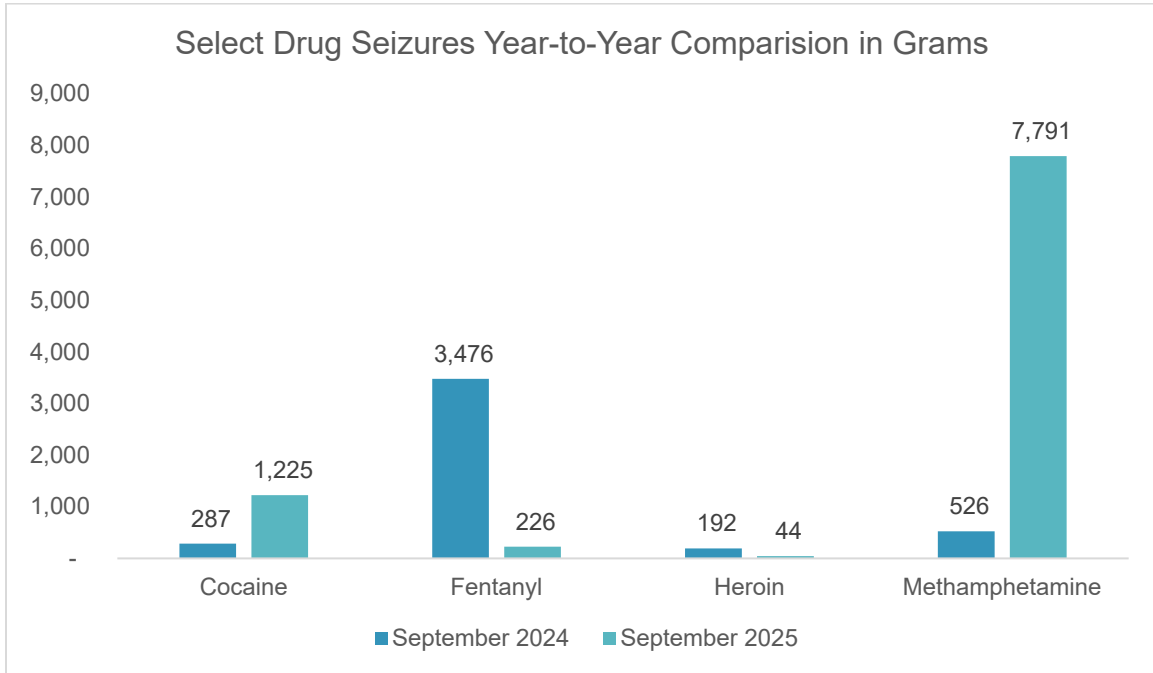
The accompanying charts provide an overview of preliminary drug and alcohol seizures by the Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit as of September 2025. The “Select Drug Seizures by Month in Grams” column chart shows a total of 19,961 grams seized.



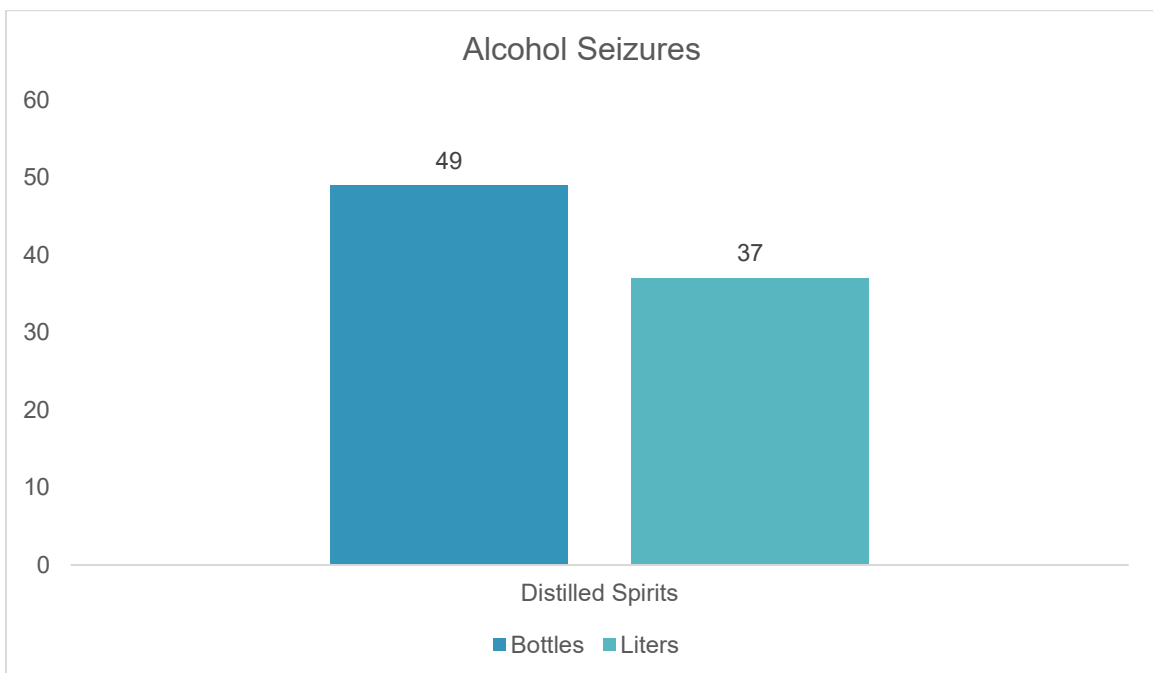
The “Select Drug Seizures Year to Date in Grams” pie chart shows cocaine as the most seized drug year-to-date.



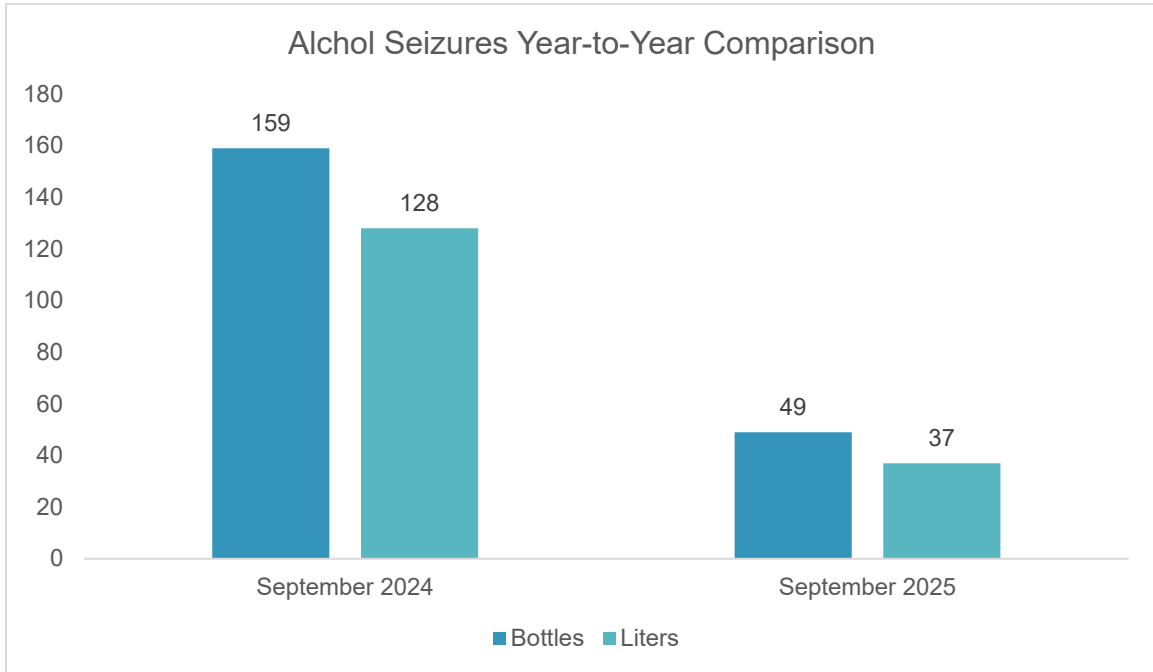
The “Select Drug Seizures Year-to-Year Comparison in Grams” column chart compares seizures for September 2024 to September 2025, demonstrating an 107% increase in total seizures. The chart reveals a 93% decrease in the amount of fentanyl seizures and a 77% decrease in the amount of heroin seizures, as well as a 1,382% increase in the amount of methamphetamine seizures and 328% increase in the amount of cocaine seizures in September 2025 compared to September 2024.



The “Alcohol Seizures” column chart breaks down alcohol seizures by total number of bottles and liters seized by alcohol type in September 2025.



The “Alcohol Seizures Year-to-Year Comparison” demonstrates an 69% decrease in bottles and 71% decrease in liters seized in September 2025 compared to September 2024.
