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USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS

Overview

The Alaska Department of Public Safety (DPS) annually publishes a five-year trend analysis Use of Force report for all Use of Force incidents involving the Alaska State Troopers, Alaska Wildlife Troopers, Court Service Officers, and Deputy Fire Marshals. This report includes data from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2022.

DPS also voluntarily participates in the US Department of Justice Law Enforcement Use of Force data collection effort.

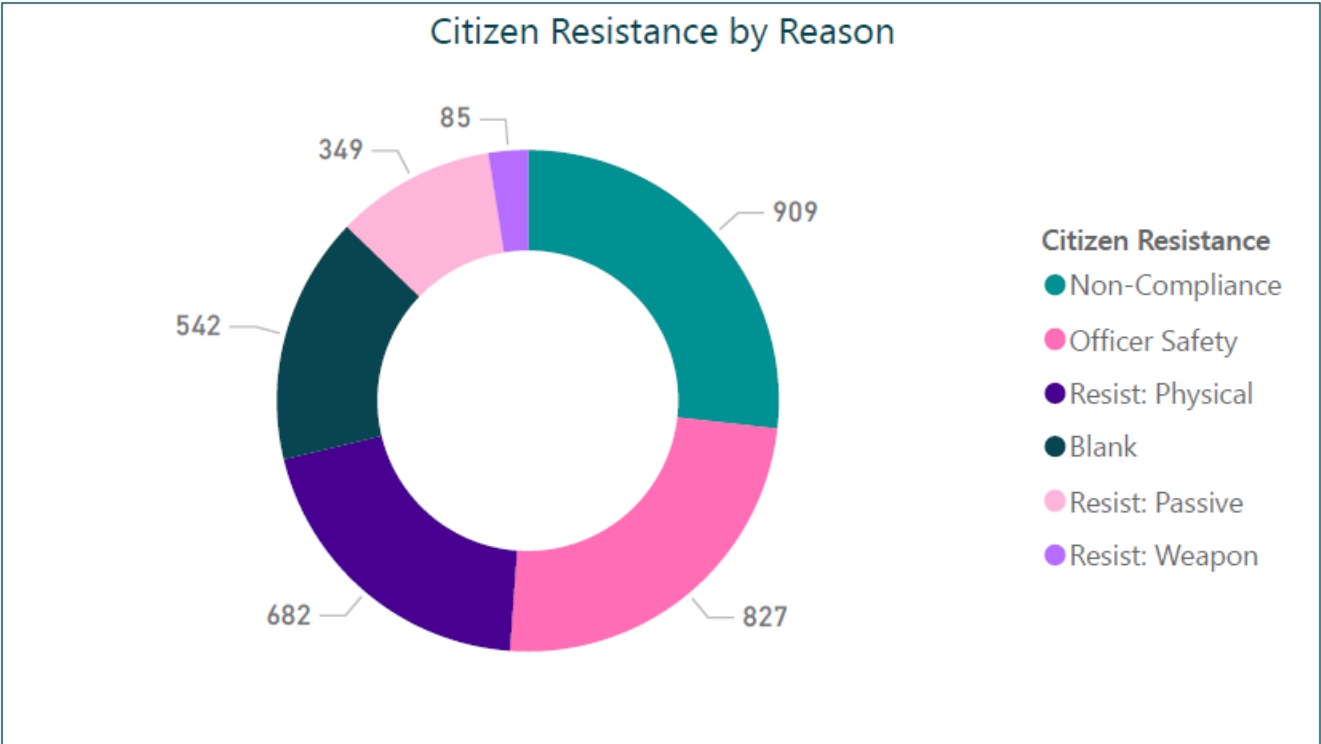
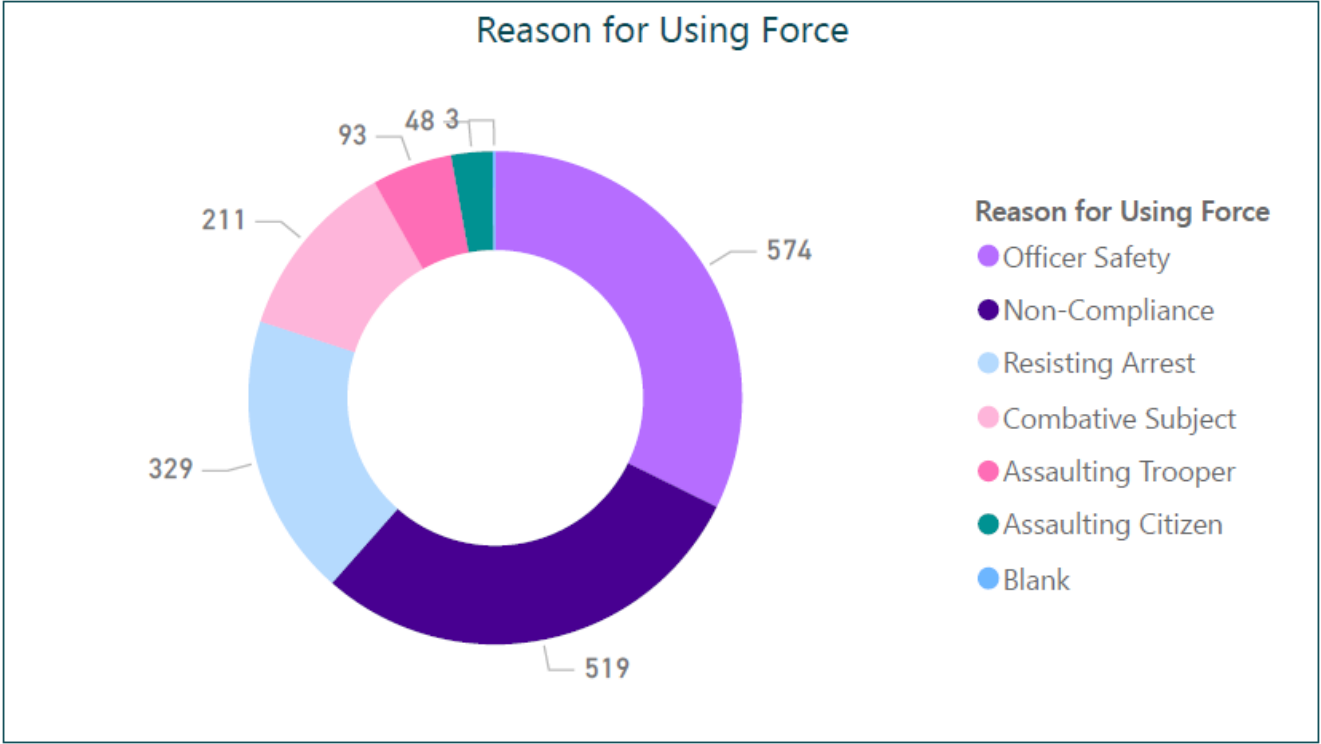

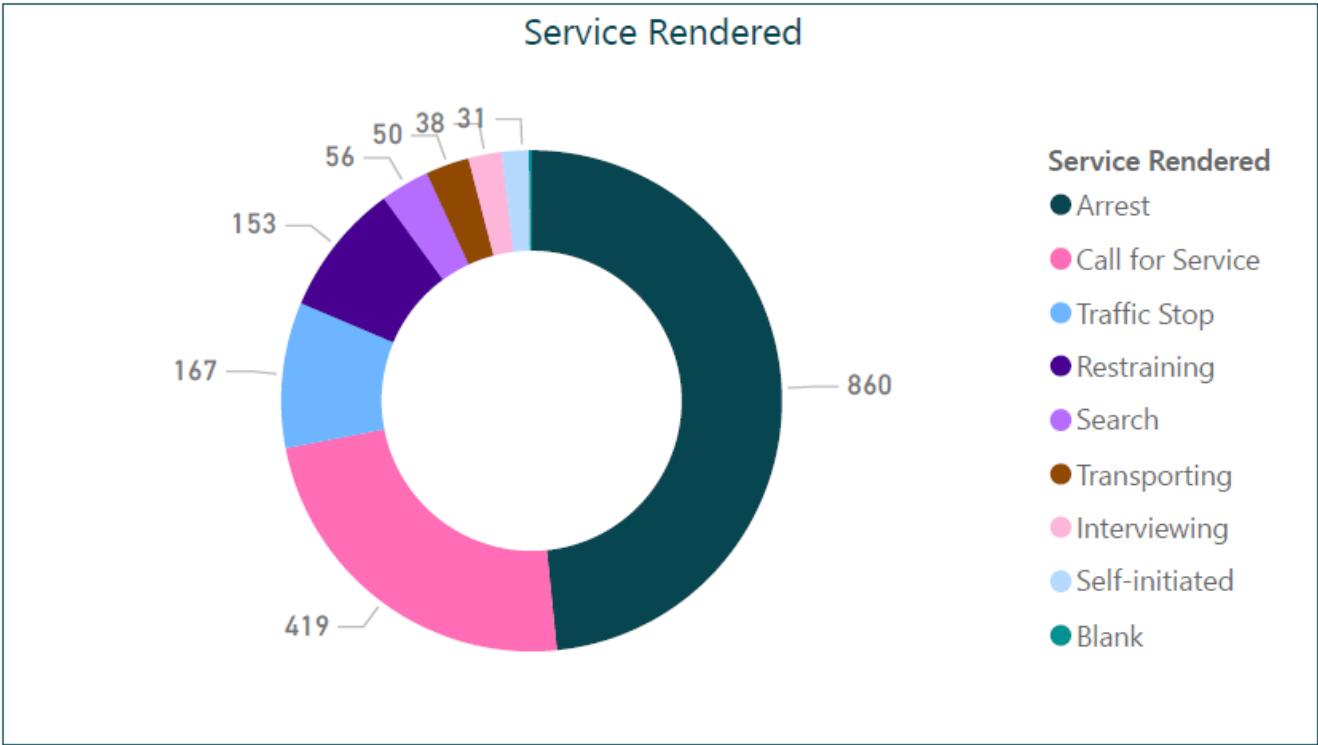
¹ An incident can have more than one type of force.

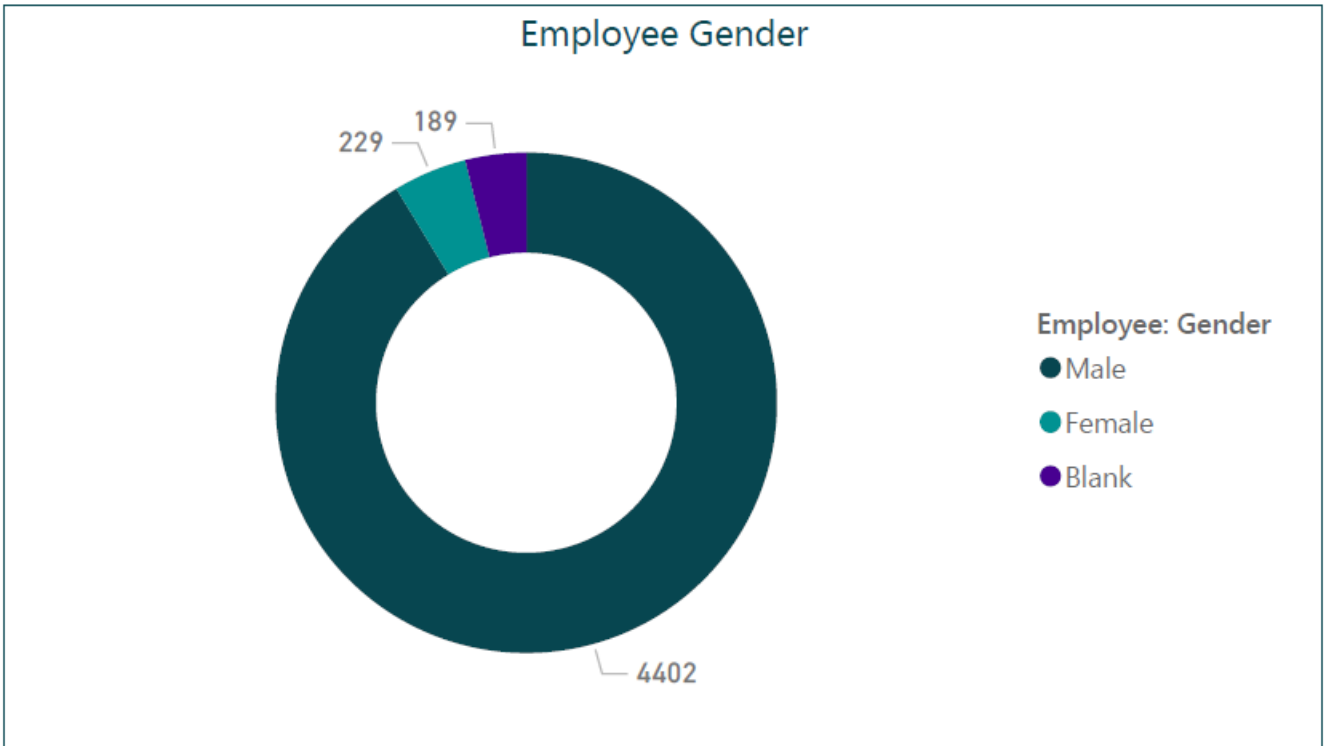
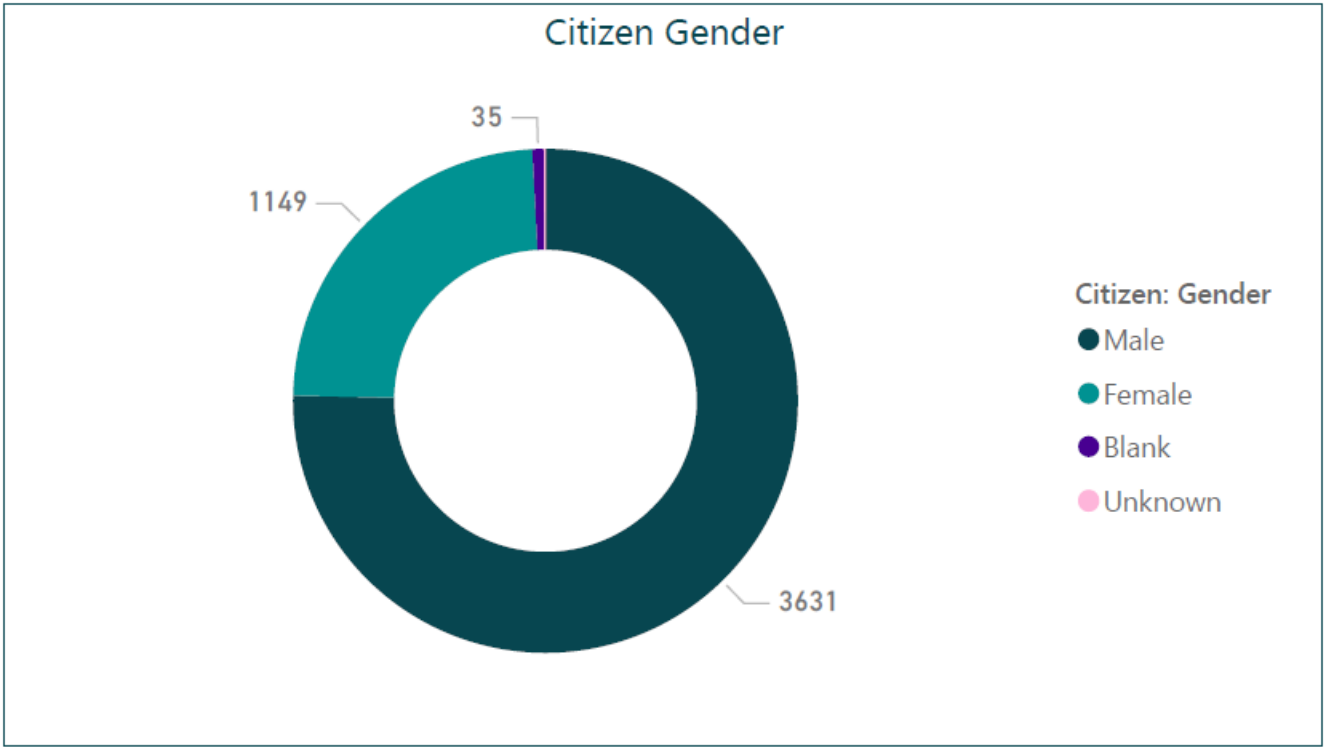
³ Use of Force incidents can have more than one reason for using force, more than one citizen resistance type, and more than one service rendered.



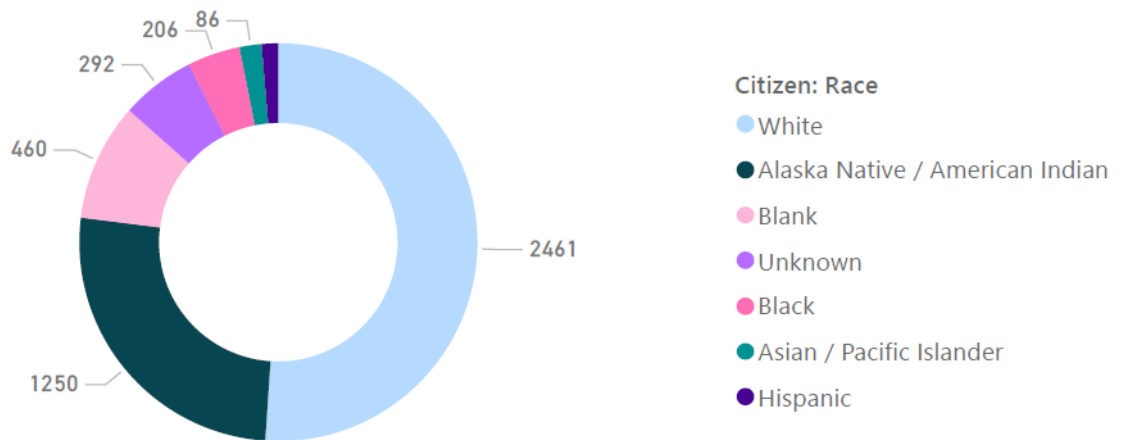

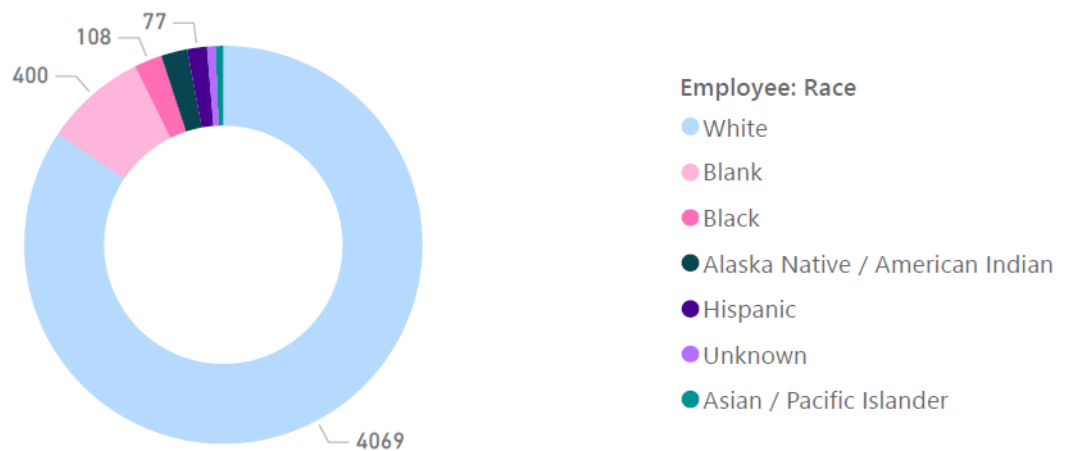

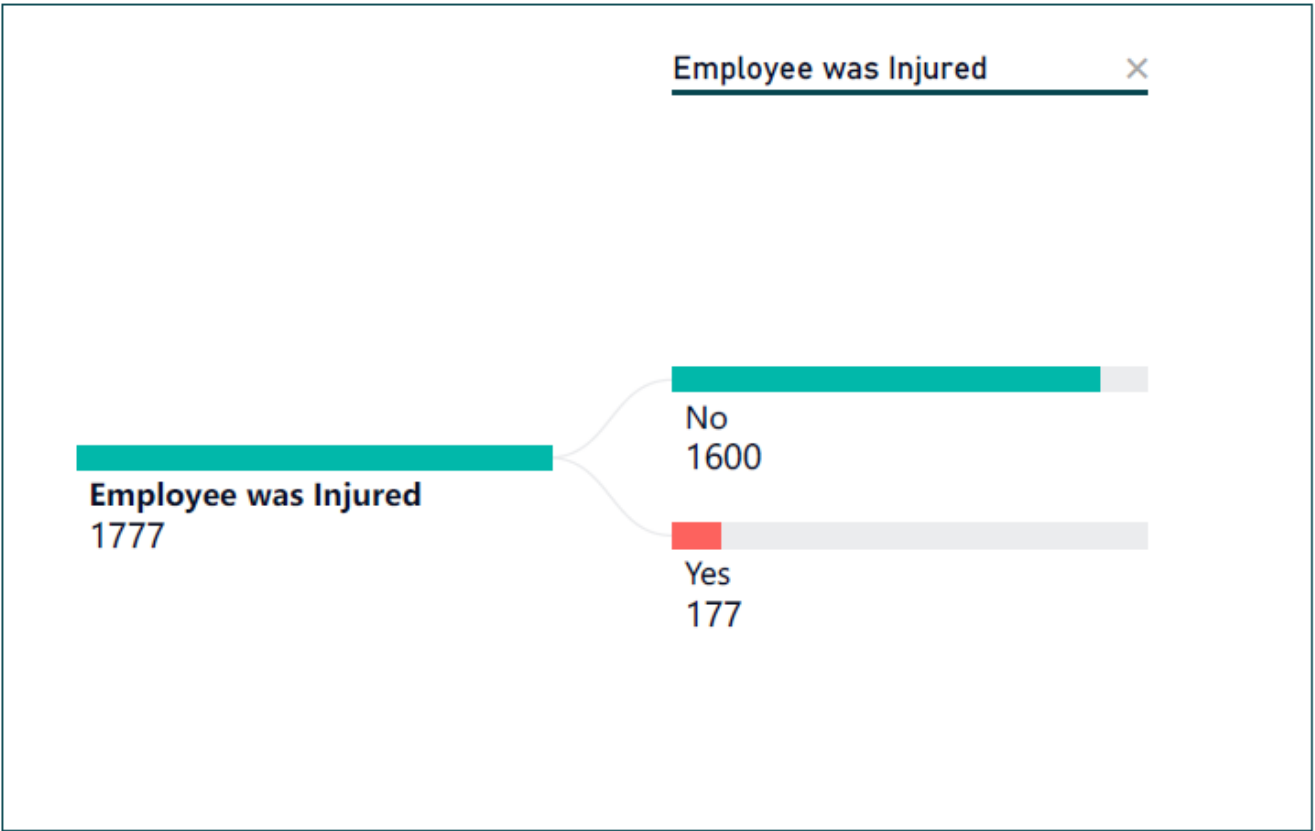
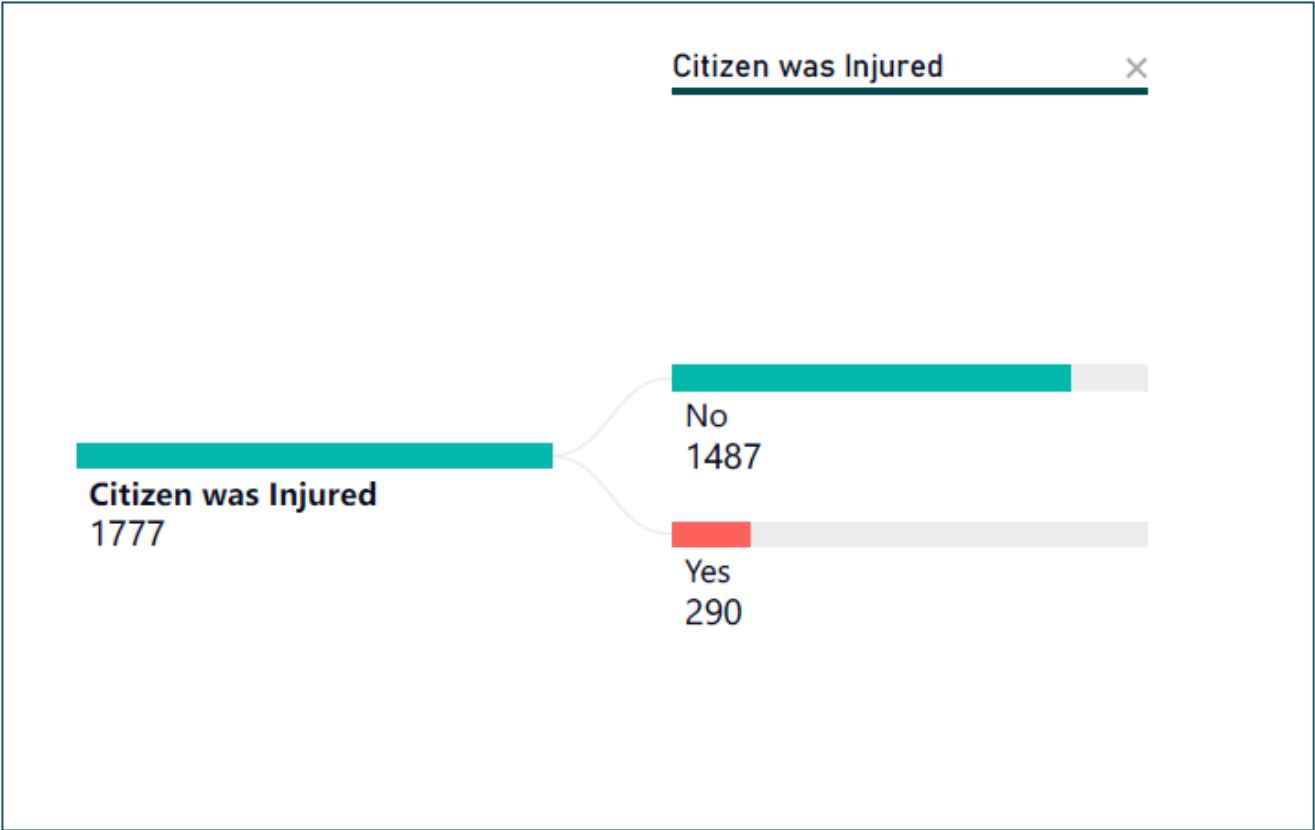
Citizen Race
